

Buses Visiting BioTrek

*** Driving Directions ***

From Los Angeles:

Take the 10 freeway EAST and exit at Kellogg Drive. Stay on Kellogg Drive. Make sure to be in the left lane; you will need to make a left turn to stay on Kellogg Drive to South Campus Drive. Make a right onto South Campus Drive until you reach Temple Avenue. Make a right onto Temple Avenue and then turn right onto University Drive. Follow University Drive until you reach **M lot** (the first stop sign you will see on campus) and make a left.

From Orange County:


Take the 57 freeway NORTH to Temple Avenue and exit west (left-hand turn) to the campus. Make a right at University Drive. Follow University Drive until you reach **Camphor Lane** and make a right.


From The Inland Empire:

Take the 10 freeway WEST and exit at Kellogg Drive. Make a right onto Kellogg Drive. Make sure to be in the left lane; you will need to make a left turn to stay on Kellogg Drive to South Campus Drive. Make a right onto South Campus Drive until you reach Temple Avenue. Make a right onto Temple Avenue and then turn right onto University Drive. Follow University Drive until you reach **M lot** (the first stop sign you will see on campus) and make a left, and then another right onto University Drive. Follow University Drive until you reach **Camphor Lane** and make a left.

From the Pasadena area:

Take the 210 freeway EAST to 57 Freeway SOUTH. Exit on Temple Avenue and turn west (right-hand turn) towards the campus. Make a right onto University Drive. Follow University Drive until you reach **Camphor Lane** and make a right.

***** Parking Information *****

School buses are free of charge. Bus parking is located in front of BioTrek along the orange curb on Camphor Lane. As you drive onto Camphor Lane, the BioTrek glass greenhouse will be on the opposite (north) side of the street. Bus drivers will need to turn the bus around in order to park in front of BioTrek. A bus turnaround area, designated for 40ft buses, is located at the end of Camphor Lane. Another option is to do a three-point turn using the handicap parking lot behind the BioTrek greenhouse. We cannot accommodate personal vehicles at BioTrek. Parking is available for \$5 in student parking lots J or M above us on University Drive.
