November 20 Department Chair: Submits criteria for lecturer range elevations to Associate Vice President for Faculty Affairs. **December 1** AVP for Faculty Affairs: Notifies lecturers eligible for a range elevation. January 31 <u>Candidate for Range Elevation</u>: **LAST** day to **submit application**. Please submit your application via Interfolio. February 13 Department Chair: Provides applications from candidates to Department Review Committee consisting of at least 3 tenured faculty members. February 13 – Feb. 26 Department Review Committee: Evaluates candidates for range elevation. February 13 – Feb. 26 Department Chair: If the Department Chair is not on the Department Review Committee, the Department Chair may evaluate candidates for range elevation. February 26 Department Review Committee: Recommendations from the committee goes through the Department Chair. The recommendation is to be in memo format, addressed to the Dean. The evaluation/recommendation from the Department Chair (if separate from the committee) is also due on this date. Feb. 26 – March 6 Candidate: Reviews recommendations from Department Review Committee and Department Chair. The candidate has ten calendar days to write a response if desired. March 6 Department Chair: Forwards recommendations and candidate's responses, if any, to the Dean.

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March 6 – March 19 Dean: Reviews recommendations from Department Review

	Committee and Department Chair and evaluates candidate for range elevation.
March 19	<u>Dean</u> : Provides a copy of his/her evaluation and recommendation to the candidate.
March 19 – March 28	<u>Candidate</u> : Reviews evaluation/recommendation from the Dean. The candidate has ten calendar days to write a response if desired.
March 28	<u>Dean</u> : Forwards recommendations ( <b>Dean's and</b> department's in memo format) and <u>candidate's responses if</u> <u>any</u> .
March 28 – April 10	Provost: Reviews recommendations and evaluates the application
April 10	Provost: Informs candidate of decision.

April 24Candidate: May submit an appeal of a negative decision to the<br/>AVP for Faculty Affairs.
