- 3.0 Overall GPA (recommended)
- GMAT/GRE or department waiver
- 2+ Years Work Experience
- If Required, the TOEFL with 213 Computer/550 Paper/80 Internet Based or IELTS with a 6



Our programs are cohort based to ensure timely completion and curriculum cohesiveness, therefore we only admit students during the fall quarter. The application deadline for Fall 2017 via www.csumentor.edu is June 15, 2017 and supporting documents (GMAT, 2 letters of recommendation, and resume) are due July 15, 2017.
