Fall 2021 Class Schedule

- Not all students and faculty will be ready to return to in-person teaching/learning in the fall. Therefore, flexibility must be built into the class schedule and the course syllabi.
- Priority for in-person instruction shall go to laboratory, activity, internship, and other classes where hands-on learning and/or specialized equipment is essential to learning outcomes. As of now, ~ **750 sections** have an in-person component.
- Whenever possible, courses with multiple sections will include online sections as well as sections with in-person components.
- Fully online classes will remain online for the duration of the semester.
- Based on public health guidelines, face-to-face and hybrid classes may increase or reduce the frequency/extent of in-person activities.

Fall 2021 Class Schedule – Continued

- We will pilot the **HyFlex** mode of instruction in Fall 2021.
 - HyFlex (hybrid-flexible) instruction mode, is an instructional approach that simultaneously offers student the option to participate in class activities synchronously in-person or virtually, or asynchronously virtually.
- Classes with enrollment of 30 or more should be offered fully online.
- Classes with in-person learning components, regardless of size, must ensure that appropriate social distancing and other risk mitigation measures are observed.
- In any given instructional space, at minimum, 30-minute passing times are scheduled in-between classes.

HyFlex (Hybrid-Flexible)

- Fall 2021 **HyFlex** Pilot
 - HyFlex (hybrid-flexible) instruction allows students to choose to attend class:
 - Face-to-Face
 - Synchronously online
 - Asynchronously online
 - 23 Faculty will each offer a class in HyFlex
 - Participate in summer training
 - Work with a student assistant
 - Will evaluate success to determine path forward
 - Student learning
 - Faculty and student satisfaction

Admissions – Impaction 2022-23

- Incorporating the Multifactor Admission (MFA) Models for both Freshmen and Transfer applicants
- Moving from supplemental course requirements to priority admission consideration
- Unimpacting programs that do not meet capacity
 - Music – Music Industry Option
 - Biotechnology
 - Environmental Biology
 - Physics
- Impacting programs that exceed capacity
 - Psychology (Freshmen & Transfer)
 - Sociology (Transfer Only)
