# Fall 2021 Planning

- Start of registration postponed from 4/5/2021 to 4/21/2021.

- Encourage students to complete [CPP Connect Planner](http://www.cpp.edu/cppconnect) ([www.cpp.edu/cppconnect](http://www.cpp.edu/cppconnect))
- Provides colleges and departments time to continue to expand the number of in-person classes.
- Working to reach ~50% of class sections with in-person teaching/learning component.
- In-Person internships were approved by the Los Angeles County of Public Health
  - For both Summer 2021 and Fall 2021
  - Faculty can work with the Center for Community Engagement
- Faculty professional development opportunities in Summer 2021

# Additional Funding for Students

- CPP received its second allocation of funding for HEERF II in Mid-March.
- Student emergency grant distribution began the week of April 5<sup>th</sup>.
- An estimated 21,000-24,000 students are eligible for the HEERF II grants.
- CPP distribution and prioritization model based on **exceptional need** determined by the 2020-21 official Expected Family Contribution (EFC).
