TITLE OF REFERRAL: EWS 2031: The Native American Historical Experience (New Area F, revision from D3)

BACKGROUND:

This is a new Area F course revised from an existing Area D3.

RESOURCES CONSULTED:

Office of Academic Programs, Ethnic Studies Ad Hoc Committee.

DISCUSSION:

This new Area F course from the EWS Department is based on a longstanding Area D3 The Native American Historical Experience course and thus needed only a few modifications to bring it into compliance with the Area F GE requirement. As is required, this course demonstrates and interdisciplinary and comparative study of race and ethnicity with special focus on four historically defined racialized core groups, with this one in particular focusing on the Native American Experience. The course fulfills all the requirements in assessment, written assignments, and activities that promote intellectual or culture growth. The GE Committee unanimously passed this referral.

RECOMMENDATION:

The GE Committee recommends that the Academic Senate adopt EWS 2031: The Native American Historical Experience (New Area F, revision from D3).
