HEERF III Student Emergency Grants

Cal Poly Pomona received \$42,594,664 to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants directly to students.

Summer 2021

- **Automatic grants** to students with **Exceptional Need** (Pell Eligible) enrolled in Summer 2021
- Grant amounts: **\$1,391**
- Eligible students: **3,175**
- Funds distributed: **\$4,416,425**

Fall 2021

- **Automatic grants** to students with **Exceptional Need** (Pell Eligible) & **High Need** (Cal Grant A) enrolled in Fall 2021
- Grant amounts: **\$1,515 & \$1,316**
- Eligible students: **17,582**
 - Exceptional Need: 14,676
 - High Need: 2,906
- Funds distributed: **\$25,535,356**

Fall 2021 (10/18-12/17)

- **Application** process for HEERF Emergency Grant Request
- Through Bronco Scholarship Portal (**BSP**)
- Open **10/18/21 to 12/17/2021**
- Grant amounts: **\$500-\$3,000**
- Eligible students: **All**
 - All students who have faced financial challenges due to the pandemic are encouraged to apply
- Funds available: **~\$13 Million**
