Out of the students that are not enrolled, **over 70%** are from the last three recent Fall cohorts. These cohorts were admitted during or shortly before the pandemic.

Spring 2022 Enrollment Efforts

- Daily monitoring of Spring enrollment.
- All financial holds have been lifted, which allows students with outstanding balances to register.
- Suspending plans to disenroll for non-payment for Spring.
- Calling efforts are underway to assist students to register.
- Several Billy Chat text messages have been sent to students, reminding them to register.
- Student Affairs has invited close to 5,000 students who have not registered for an in-person and virtual registration help event that will take place on Thursday, December 2. While registration will be closed on this day, we will register any student at this event.
- Special Registration Window will be open from December 3 - 14 for students that have not enrolled by December 2.

What can you do?

- Check with students in your classes or student assistants in your department to ask if they've registered for classes.

Spring 2022 Semester Class Schedule

- Classes will be taught in the scheduled modality
- Hybrid classes required to have both face-to-face and online meeting patterns in the schedule
