DUAL ENROLLMENT

DID YOU TAKE CLASSES AT A COMMUNITY COLLEGE OR OTHER UNIVERSITY?

- CPP NEEDS OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPTS
- COLLEGES WILL NOT SEND TRANSCRIPTS ON YOUR BEHALF
- IF THE CLASS IS A NON-A-G COURSE, IT MAY NOT APPEAR ON HS TRANSCRIPT

CAN I TAKE SUMMER COURSES?

- Yes, students can take Community College courses during the Summer
- A-G requirements must be met high school graduation





EXTERNAL EXAMS



Advanced Placement (AP)

- Official score report from CollegeBoard
- Score of 3 or higher
- Up to 6 units of college credit (per exam)


International Baccalaureate (IB)

- Score of 4 or higher on HL (Higher Level) exams
- Up to 9 units of college credit (per exam)




TWO STEP PROCESS IN BRONCO DIRECT:

BRONCO ORIENTATION EXPERIENCE

- Advising and Registration is built into your Orientation Day
 - You will meet with an advisor during your scheduled orientation
- Each of you have unique needs and wants at CPP, we want to ensure you have a say in your orientation experience
 - Students will see four learning pathway options at the point of registration
 - We encourage you to read through each pathway description as you decide what your Bronco Orientation Experience will entail
- Students and their guests will have two separate orientation experiences
 - Parent and Family Orientation is meant to provide guidance and information to your supporters as they learn to navigate CPP and join the Bronco Family



ORIENTATION RESERVATION

- Students can make a reservation via MyCPP- BroncoDirect.
 - Registration will open on Wednesday, May 1
 - Students must have submitted their Intent to Enroll to make an orientation reservation
 - Students are allowed up to two guests with their reservation
- The final deadline to make an orientation reservation is Monday, June 3 at 11:59pm
 - Failure to make an orientation reservation will result in your CPP admission being withdrawn
- Adjusting Your Reservation
 - To add a guest, please do not cancel your current reservation
 - Students can contact <u>orientation@cpp.edu</u> to make any updates to their current reservation



WHAT IF I'M NOT SURE ABOUT MY MAJOR?

Can I change my major later?

- Change of major can only be requested after the first term, for unimpacted majors
- Impacted majors have additional, specific requirements to change majors. These requirements may take multiple years to complete.
