- Final transcripts due by 7/15 (grades through Spring 2024)



- Asynchronous and self-paced
- Complete Parts 1 & 2 prior to your live orientation
- Completion of your pre-orientation modules is mandatory

- Session availability is based on your academic record
- Attendance to your live orientation session is mandatory
