Bilingual Authorization Requirements

For a Bilingual Authorization, students are required to declare a concentration in Chicano/Latino Studies or Asian American Studies. Courses for the C/L concentration must include: EWS 402 and SPN 401. Additionally, language proficiency in Spanish is required at the high-intermediate level or greater in listening, speaking, reading & writing, as determined by the California State Polytechnic University, Pomona Spanish Bilingual Authorization Exam. Courses for the Asian concentration must include a culture course of a target Asian group and the passing of Subset #6 Asian American in the target language (Korean, Mandarin, Cantonese, Cambodian or Vietnamese).

To graduate with a BA Credential, students must also complete 5 extra units of TED 515/515A.
