TOTAL CURRICULUM MUST INCLUDE 60 UPPER DIVISION UNITS. ONLY 52 UPPER DIVISION UNITS ARE AMONG THE REQUIRED COURSES. YOU MAY NEED TO TAKE 8 UPPER DIVISION UNITS IN YOUR CONCENTRATION OR "UNRESTRICTED ELECTIVES" TO MAKE THE 60 TOTAL.

TO GRADUATE FROM CAL POLY POMONA, STUDENTS MUST TAKE AT LEAST 75 UNITS AT FOUR-YEAR COLLEGES, OF WHICH AT LEAST 50 MUST BE AT CAL POLY POMONA. AMONG THESE 50 UNITS AT CAL POLY POMONA, AT LEAST 12 UNITS MUST BE IN GENERAL EDUCATION, 18 UNITS MUST BE IN CORE, AND 36 UNITS MUST BE IN UPPER DIVISION COURSES. SEE ADVISOR FOR DETAILS.
