# **Professional Work Experience (PWE)**

\*A minimum of 800-hours of PWE must be completed and documented prior to enrolling in HRT 341.

Collins College students must perform a minimum of 800 hours of PWE. PWE is any hospitality industry work performed after high school graduation. PWE is documented on company letterhead and letters should show the total hours worked and explain the student's job description(s) and related duties. It is recommended that PWE show growth in knowledge and skills above those of an entry-level employee.

## Series Courses

\*\* HRT 382 and HRT 383L must be taken in two consecutive guarters. When students enroll in HRT 382, they must select one of two options available. The lunch option will require students to take HRT 382-01 and HRT 383L-01. The dinner option will require students to take HRT 382-02 and HRT 383L-02.
