Advising Notes:

1. This sheet is to be used in conjunction with the other sheets in blackboard under the organization site (Agribusiness and Food Industry Management).
2. This shows how an ABM student would schedule all of their requirements to complete their degree in 4 years. This plan is for a freshman entering as an ABM student who does not change majors. If a student is a transfer or change of major they should see their ABM advisor to determine how this needs to be adjusted.
3. You must pay attention to completing the 100 and 200 level GE, ABM support and ABM core courses during your freshman and sophomore years. Do not put those off.
4. If you are taking remedial math take STA 120 the following quarter (or they will make you retake remedial math).
5. You must have 180 units to graduate.
