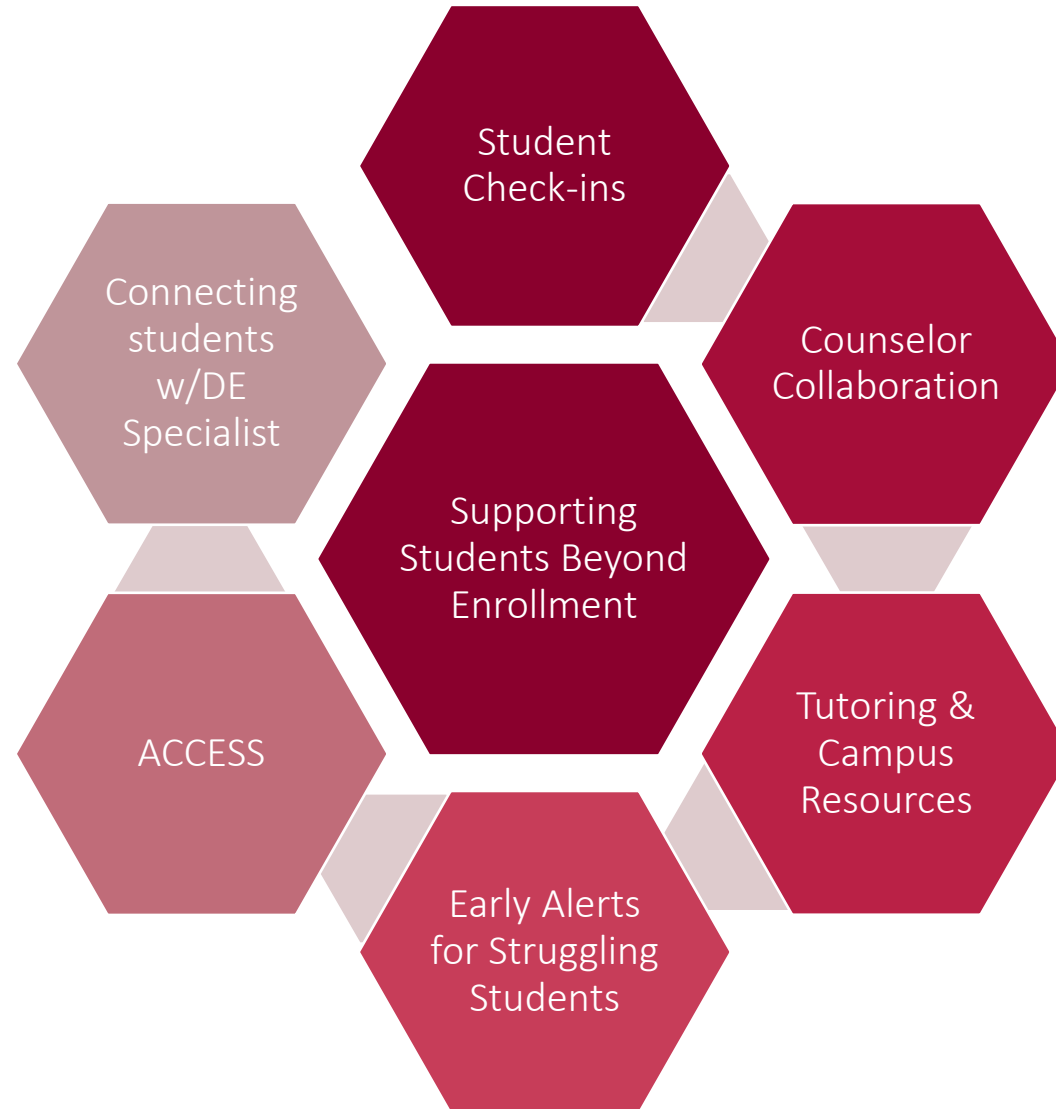

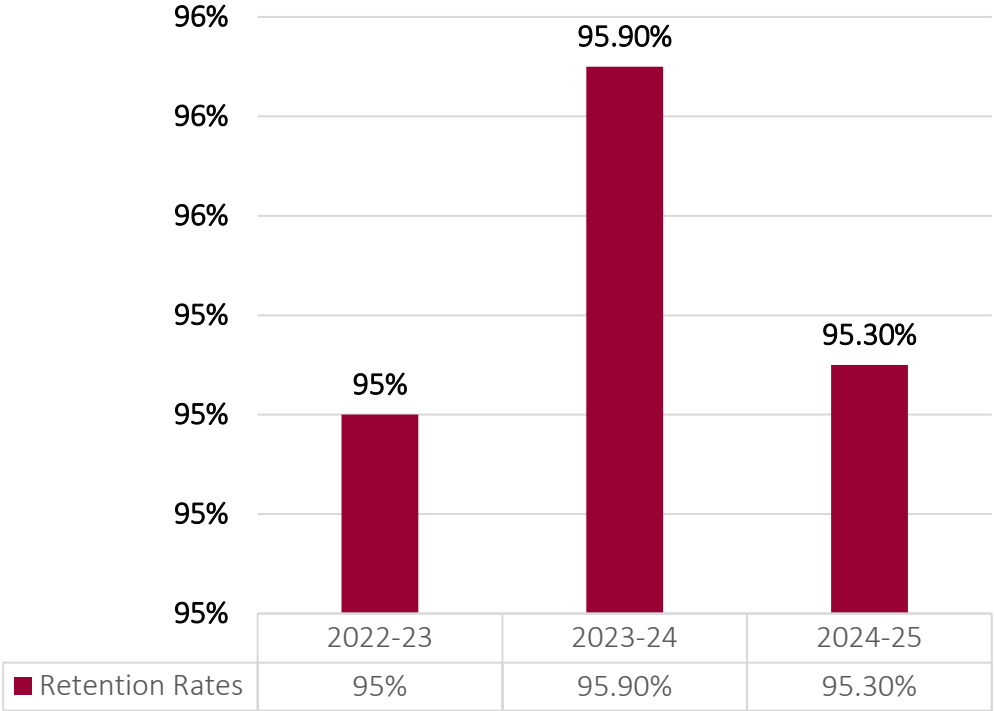
SUCCESS & RETENTION TRENDS

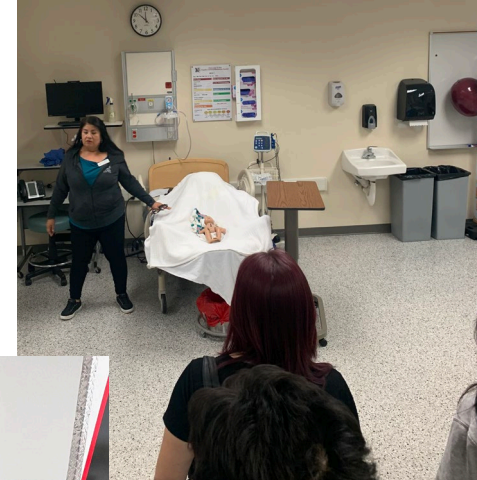
Outcomes of Success
