What is CPP Choice?

- As an applicant to an impacted major, not all eligible applicants can be admitted to their desired major
- CPP Choice offers an admission pathway into an alternative major that aligns with interests, curriculum, and careers





CPP Choice

Why did I get CPP Choice?

- CSU Eligible
- Primary choice major at capacity

Can I change my major later?

- Yes, you may request to change majors

Is a change of major guaranteed?

- No, it is not. Specific requirements may need to be met depending on the major.

Provisional Admission

Students are *provisionally* admitted based on self-reported information from the Cal State Apply application.

All admission requirements must be completed by high school graduation.

Our office will verify all admission requirements are met via official transcripts.





Transcripts

- **Must be official**
- **Be sent by third party transcript/testing service:**
 - Parchment
 - National Clearinghouse
 - eTranscript California
 - CollegeBoard
- **Be directly sent from the school to:**

- **Mailed to:**

- **Final transcripts due by 7/15** (posted graduation date and grades through senior year)





Dual Enrollment

Did you take classes at a Community College or other university?

- CPP needs official transcripts
- Colleges will not send transcripts on your behalf
- If the class is a non-A-G course, it may not appear on HS transcript

Can I take summer courses?

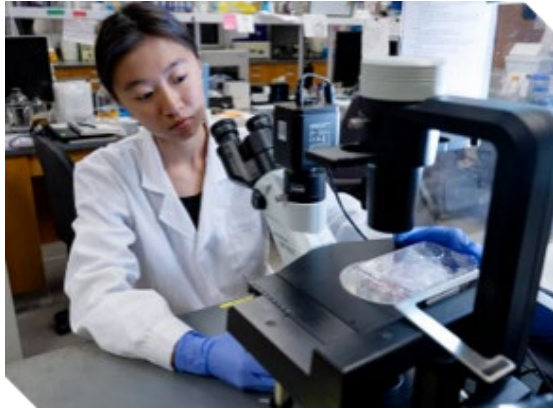
- Yes, students can take community college courses during the summer
- A-G requirements must be met by high school graduation





External Exams (if applicable)

Official scores needed for proper awarding of transfer credit.



Advanced Placement (AP)

- Official score report from CollegeBoard
- Score of 3 or higher
- Up to 6 units of college credit (per exam)



International Baccalaureate (IB)

- Score of 4 or higher on HL (Higher Level) exams
- Up to 9 units of college credit (per exam)

SCHOOL CODE: 4082



Intent to Enroll: Due May 1, 2026

- \$150 deposit (if applicable) goes towards Fall fees
- If you are eligible for a waiver based on financial aid info, the portal will tell you
- Deposit is non-refundable and non-transferable

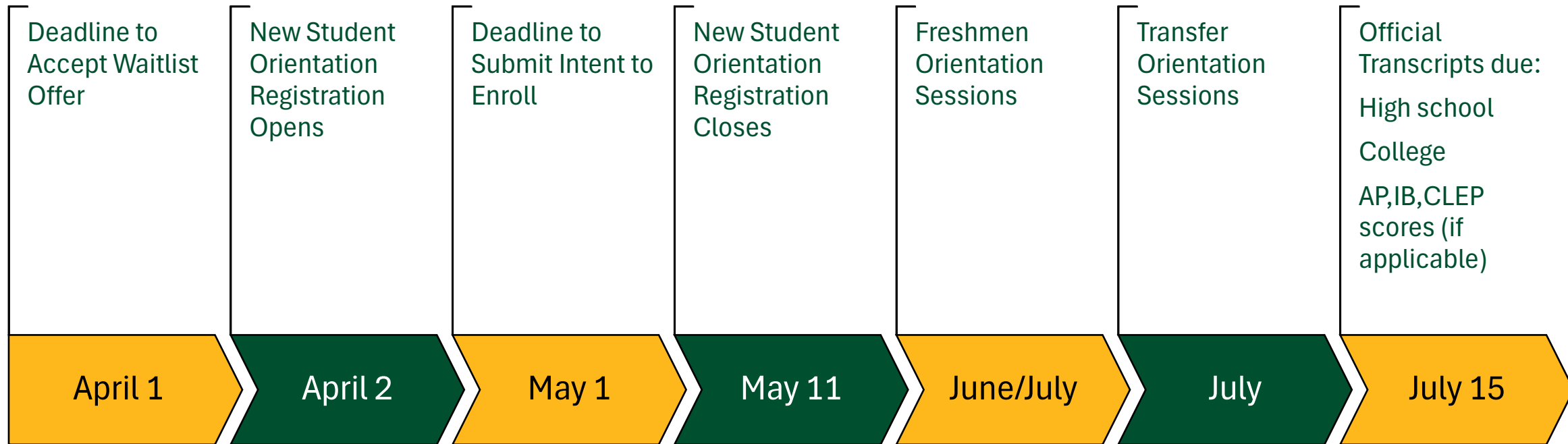

- Failure to meet required action items will result in your admission being withdrawn

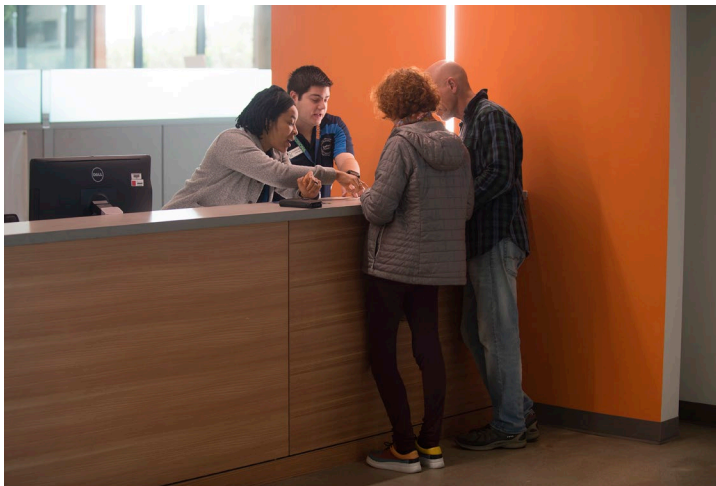
Must do checklist:

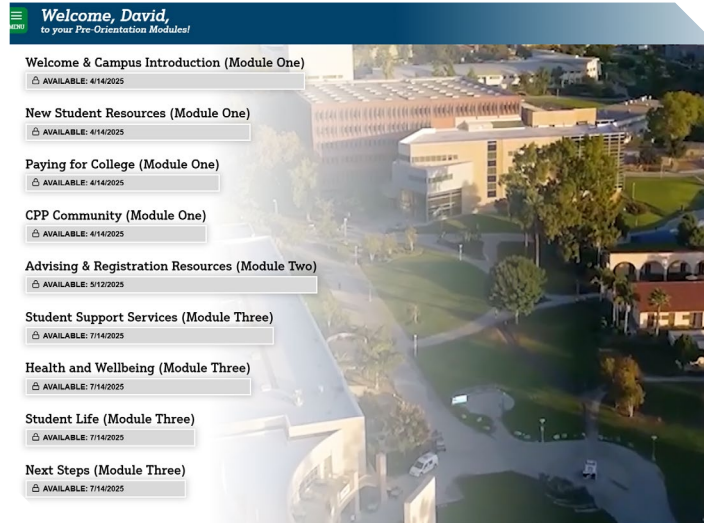

Elements of Orientation



- Pre-Orientation Modules
- Asynchronous and Self-Paced
- Complete Parts 1 & 2 prior to attending orientation
- Completion is **mandatory**



- Attending In-Person Orientation is **mandatory**
- Sessions held every Monday, Wednesday, & Friday
Freshman: June 8 – July 8
Availability is based on your academic record



What to Expect During Orientation

ACADEMIC CONNECTION

- Introduction to Academic College and Major
- Engage in academic advising and Fall course registration

PEER CONNECTION

- Connect with other incoming students and current students
- Engage in dialogue with orientation leaders about navigating CPP

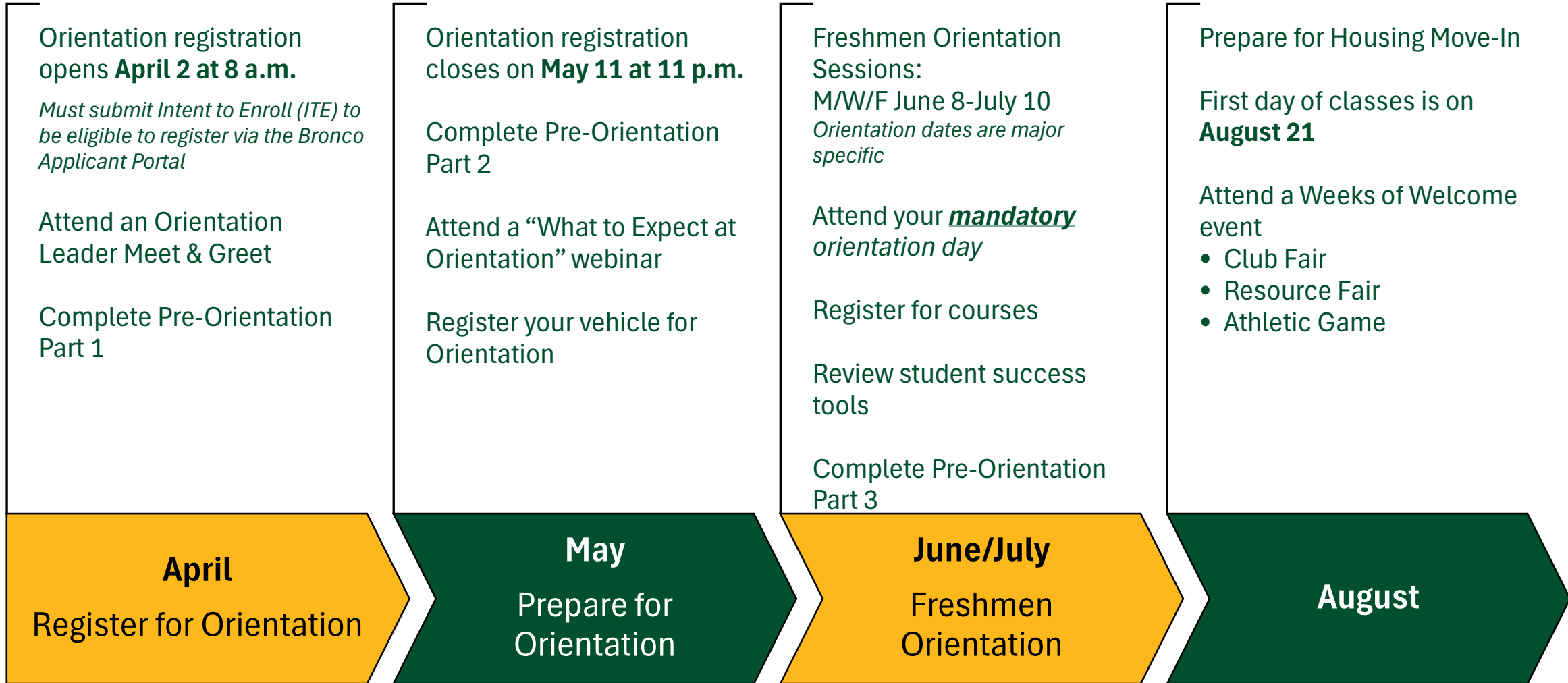
UNDERSTAND CPP RESOURCES & SUPPORT SERVICES

- Participate in an interactive learning pathway





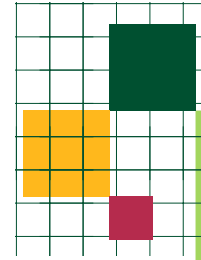
Fall 2026 – Orientation Timeline

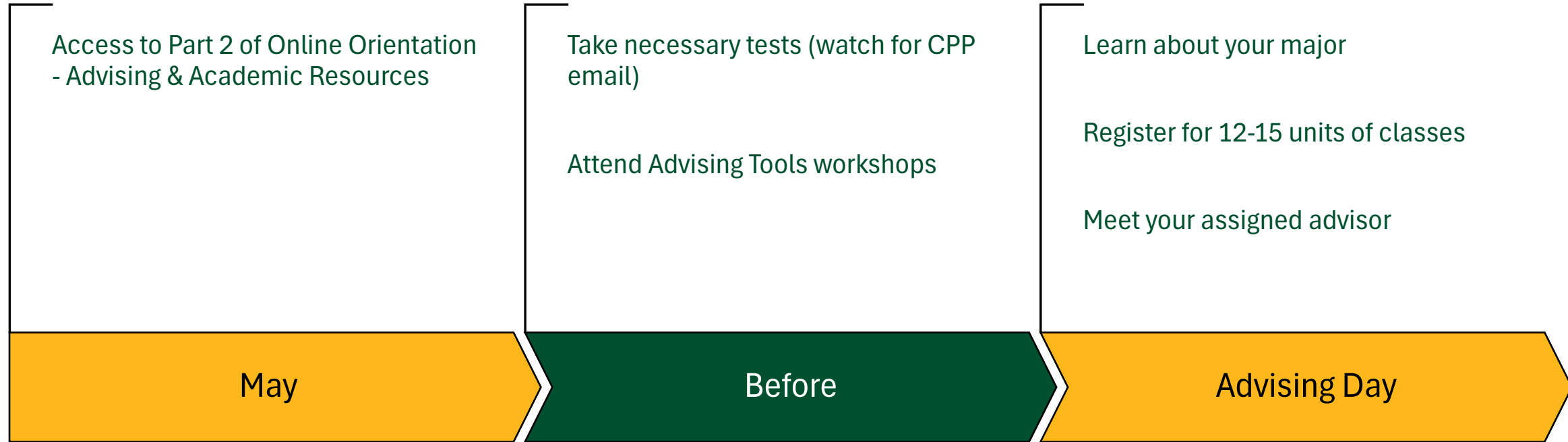

Orientation: What to Expect

- **Group Advising**
 - Meet students in your major
 - Major-specific advisor
- **Overview of your major**
 - Opportunities for clubs, co-curriculars & career options
- **Guidance on Classes**
 - General education and major courses
 - Review curriculum sheets and roadmaps
- **Time to Register**
 - 12-15 units
 - Plan for Fall and Spring





After Advising

- In the Fall: you can schedule a one-on-one appointment with your advisor
- Reach out to the Bronco Advising Center for general questions
- Visit Student Success Central for advising directory and info about assigned advisor
- Pay attention to Billy Chat text messages
 - You can text Billy questions 24/7
 - CPP will send you reminders about dates, announcements and campus services
 - Check or update your cell phone number so Billy can reach you
 - Save Billy's number in your phone!



What if I'm not sure about my major?

Can I change my major later?

- Change of major can only be requested after the first term, for unimpacted majors
- Impacted majors have additional, specific requirements to change majors. These requirements may take multiple years to complete.

Recommendation:

- In the fall, meet with a career counselor and faculty to discuss which majors can help you achieve your career goals
