# Provisional Admission

Students are *provisionally* admitted based on self-reported information from the Cal State Apply application.

All admission requirements must be completed by the end of Spring term.

Our office will verify all admission requirements are met via official transcripts.





# Transcripts

- **Must be official**
  - If sent by institution, must be from school official
- **Be sent by third party transcript/testing service:**
  - Parchment
  - National Clearinghouse
  - eTranscript California
  - CollegeBoard
  - Certified Credential Evaluation Service
  - Directly from institution from school official
- **Be directly sent from the school to:**  
verify@cpp.edu
- **Mailed to Cal Poly Pomona**
  - 3801 W. Temple Ave, Pomona, CA 91768
- **Final transcripts due by 7/15 (posted graduation date and grades through final term)**





# Dual Enrollment (freshmen)

## Did you take classes at a Community College or other university?

- CPP needs official transcripts
- Colleges will not send transcripts on your behalf
- If the class is a non-A-G course, it may not appear on HS transcript

## Can I take summer courses?

- Yes, students can take community college courses during the summer
- A-G requirements must be met high school graduation





# English Proficiency

## English Proficiency Waivers:

- If you have studied at least 3 years of full-time enrollment at a secondary/high school where English is the principal language of instruction.
- If all transfer criteria (60 units and “golden 4” with a grade of C- or better) are completed at a US institution.
- Completion of level 5 at Cal Poly English Language Institute (CPELI)
- Countries where English is the national language include: Antigua, Australia, Bahamas, Barbados, Belize, Bermuda, Botswana, Canada (except Québec), Ghana, Guyana, Ireland, Jamaica, Kenya, New Zealand, Nigeria, Scotland, South Africa, Trinidad, the United Kingdom, the United States, Virgin Islands and Wales

# External Exams



## Advanced Placement (AP)

- Official score report from CollegeBoard
- Score of 3 or higher
- Up to 6 units of college credit (per exam)



## International Baccalaureate (IB)

- Score of 4 or higher on HL (Higher Level) exams
- Up to 9 units of college credit (per exam)

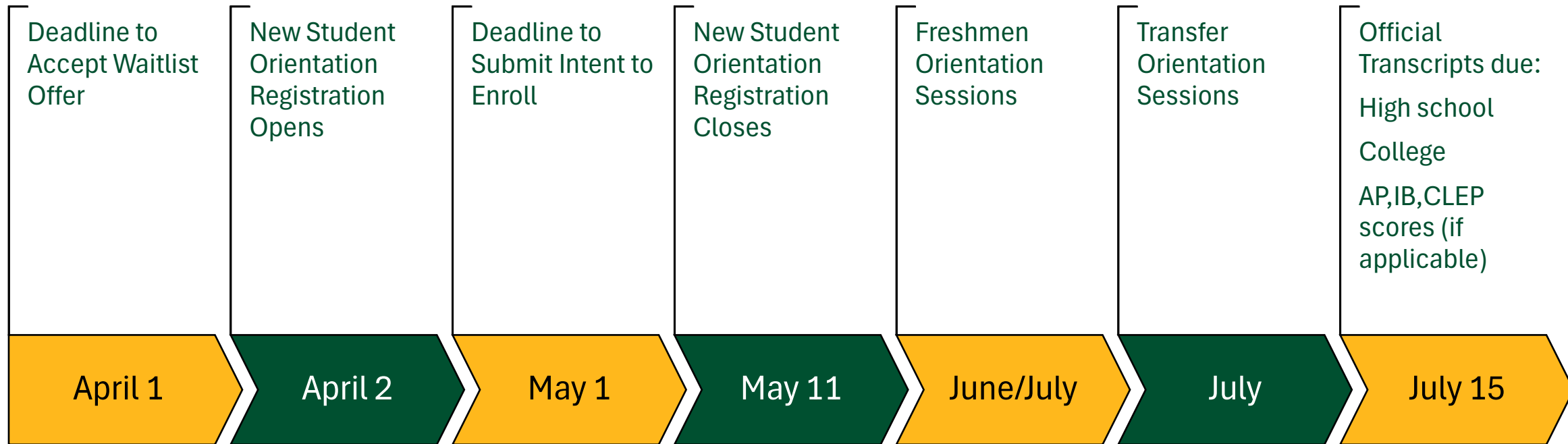

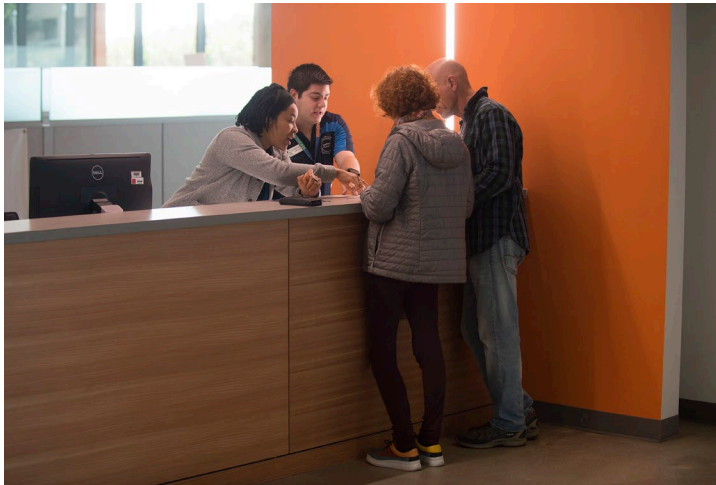

**Be mindful of the visa appointment availability with the US Embassy when requesting an I-20**



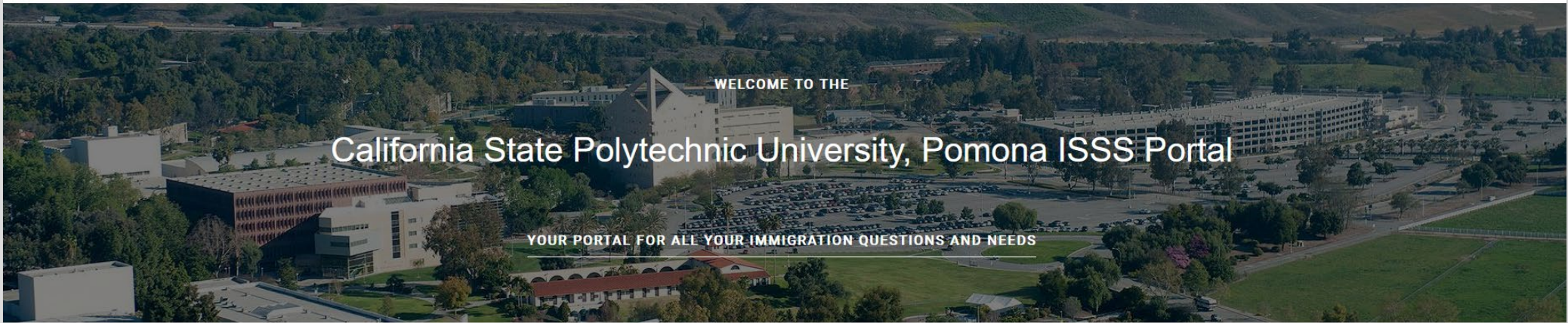



# Transfer Students

- Contact your previous school to request a SEVIS transfer

Cal Poly Pomona School Code: LOS214F00334000

- If your SEVIS record is transferred before the program start date and your I-20 request is submitted in the ISSS portal, your request will be processed and you will be notified by email when your I-20 is available in the ISSS portal.



# Pre-Departure Checklist



- Pay the I-901 SEVIS Fee & Apply for F-1 Visa *(Only for initial students. Transfer students with an active SEVIS transfer do not need to pay the fee again.)*



- Purchase health insurance & complete vaccination requirements



- Secure housing and purchase flight tickets



- Attend the mandatory international student orientation on August 19, 2026, 12:00 – 2:00PM.



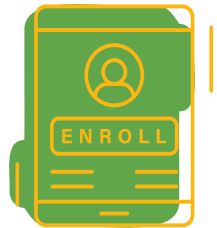

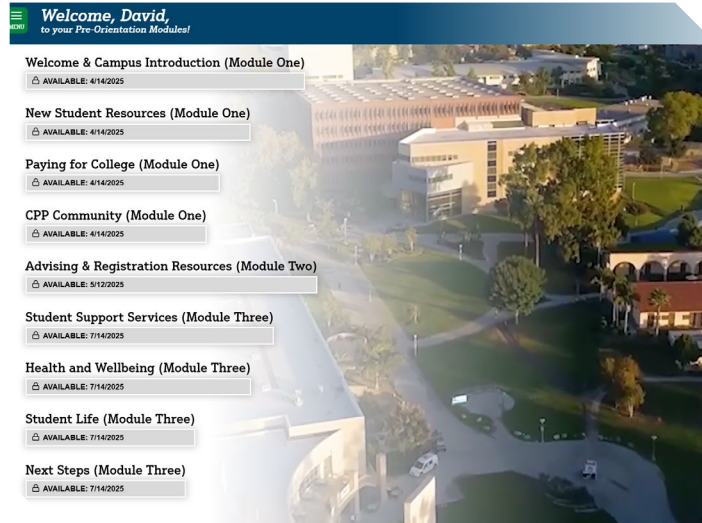

# Elements of Orientation



- Pre-Orientation Modules
- Asynchronous and Self-Paced
- Complete Parts 1 & 2 prior to attending orientation
- Completion is **mandatory**



- Attending In-Person Orientation is **mandatory**
- Sessions held every Monday, Wednesday, & Friday
  - Freshman: June 9 – July 11
  - Transfer/Returners: July 21-Aug 1

Availability is based on your academic record

- Introduction to Academic College and Major
- Engage in academic advising and Fall course registration

## PEER CONNECTION

- Connect with other incoming students and current students
- Engage in dialogue with orientation leaders about navigating CPP

## UNDERSTAND CPP RESOURCES & SUPPORT SERVICES

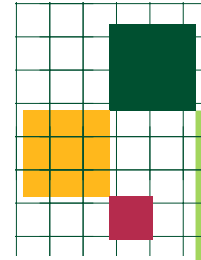
- Be able to identify at least one campus resource or support service

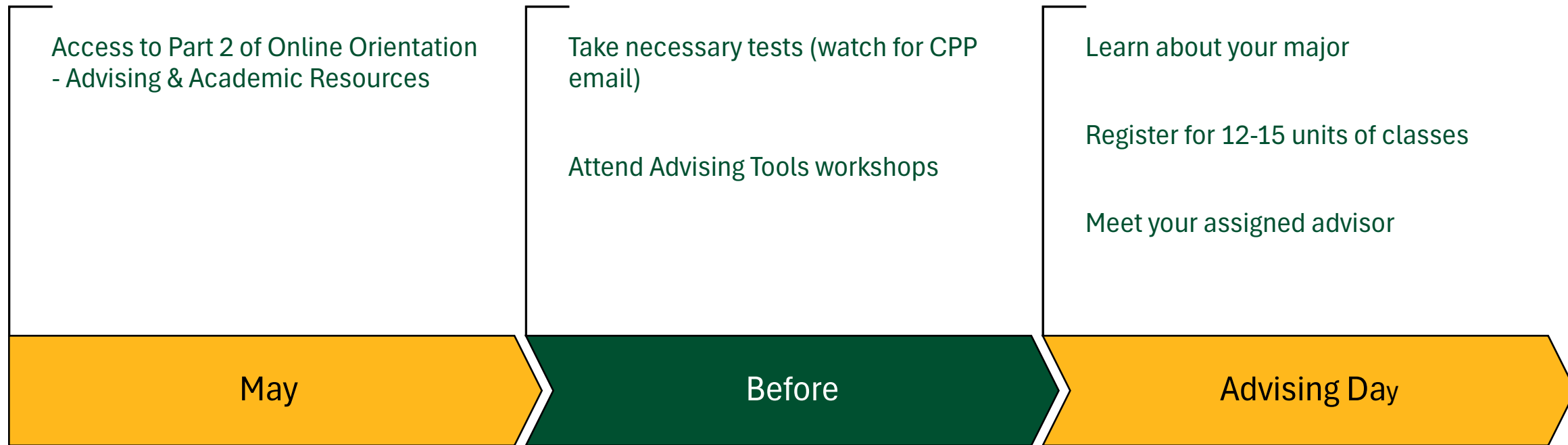

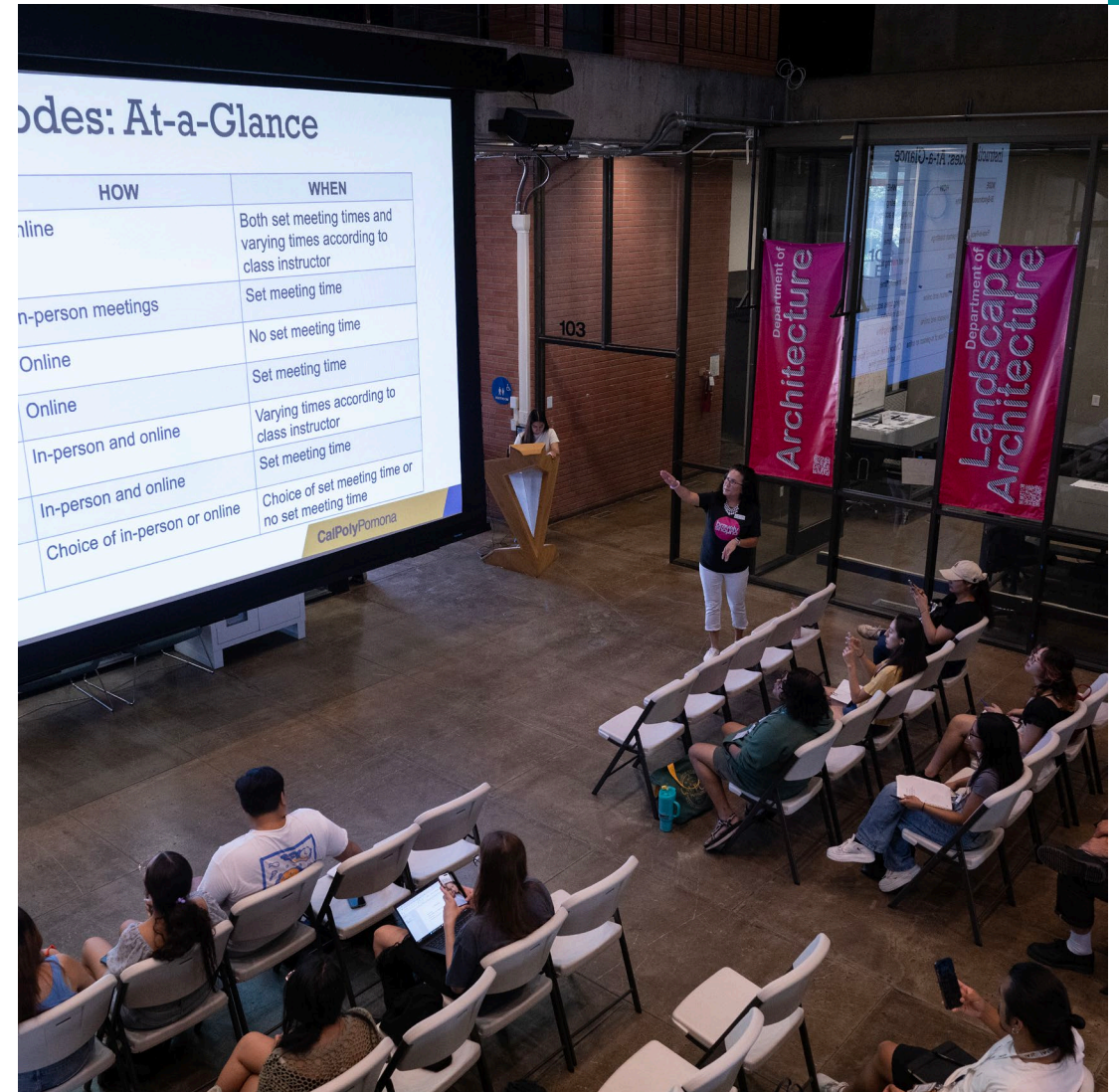

  - Review curriculum sheets and roadmaps
- **Time to Register**
  - 12-15 units
  - Plan for Fall and Spring





# After Advising

- In the Fall: you can schedule a one-on-one appointment with your advisor
- Reach out to the Bronco Advising Center for general questions
- Visit Student Success for advising directory and info about assigned advisor
- Pay attention to Billy Chat text messages
  - You can text Billy questions 24/7
