## WESTERN UNDERGRADUATE EXCHANGE (WUE)

WUE is open to all applicants, freshmen and transfer, who are residents of the Western Interstate Commission for Higher Education (WICHE) states. Cal Poly Pomona (CPP) applicants who are residents of WICHE states are automatically considered for WUE. No additional application is necessary. Award recipients are selected based on their academic profile (GPA and SAT/ACT test scores), and will be issued to the top WUE admits. If granted, WUE recipients pay 150% of resident tuition (non-resident fees waived for four years for freshmen and two years for transfer students). ## WHAT IS IMPACTION?

Cal Poly Pomona is an impacted campus and a number of individual majors are also impacted. Impaction means we receive more applications from qualified students than can be admitted. Supplemental criteria may be required for freshmen and transfer applicants. Freshmen requirements include a higher Eligibility Index (GPA and SAT/ACT) while transfer requirements include a higher GPA and additional major preparation. ## FIRST TIME FRESHMEN ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must graduate from high school and complete the following A-G college preparatory courses with a grade of “C-” or better.

### A-G COLLEGE PREPARATORY COURSE REQUIREMENTS

#### A History/Social Sciences

2 years required

One year of U.S. history or one semester of U.S. history and one semester of civics or American government AND one year of social science.

#### B English

4 years required

Four years of college-preparatory English. No more than one year of English as a Second Language (ESL).

#### C Mathematics

3 years required (4 years preferred)

Three years of college-preparatory math (Algebra I, Geometry, Algebra II, Trigonometry, Calculus, etc.).

#### D Laboratory Science

2 years required

One biological and one physical science.

#### E Language other than English

2 years required

Two years of the same language other than English.

#### F Visual & Performing Arts (VPA)

1 year required

One year of one of the following disciplines: Dance, Music, Theater, Visual Arts (painting, web/graphic design, film/video, inter/multimedia arts).

#### G College Preparatory Elective

1 year required

One year in addition to the required A-G courses listed above.

### CSU TESTING REQUIREMENTS:

#### TEST SCORES

All applicants are required to submit SAT/ACT scores no later than January 31. Submit test scores via:

SAT to CPP: 3594 | ACT to CPP: 0202

#### ELIGIBILITY INDEX (EI)

Admission for first time freshmen applicants is based on the EI. The EI is a combination of your high school grades and SAT/ACT test scores.

## TRANSFER ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Cal Poly Pomona only accepts upper division transfer students (60+ semester or 90+ quarter units).

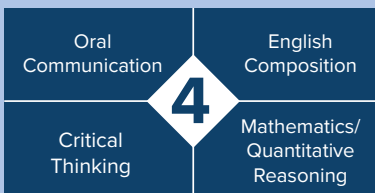
### MINIMUM CSU REQUIREMENTS:

1 Good academic standing at the last college/university attended

2 Minimum 2.0 GPA in transferable coursework

3 Completed at least 60 total transferable semester units (90 quarter) prior to transferring

4 30 of 60 semester units or 45 of 90 quarter units must be in General Education, including the “Golden Four” courses:



### TRANSFER REQUIREMENTS MUST BE COMPLETED BY THE END OF:

• Spring term prior to entering for Fall

• Summer term prior to entering for Spring
