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Office of Assessment and Program Review

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Why report?

- Opportunity to share assessment activities
- Capture extent to which students are learning
- Findings and reflection of findings may be used for other reports, e.g., program review self-studies, accreditation reports, department reports to the dean etc.
- Yes, compliance too

Sections of the Annual Assessment Report

- Identification of programs
- Development and documentation of SLOs
- Assessment activities in 2021-2022
- Improvement through assessment
- AY2021-2022 challenges
- DEI-related equity gaps (undergraduates refer to GI2025)
- Certificate/credential assessment-related details (new!)

Note: Logic has been built in the *Qualtrics* survey

2021-2022 Assessment Activities

- Changes to assessment documents (assessment plan, curriculum matrix)
- Collect/score direct evidence (i.e., student work)
 - What evidence is used
- Collect/analyze indirect evidence (e.g., surveys, focus groups, etc.)
- Analyze/assessment findings
- Develop/implement closing-the-loop strategies
- Additional investigation
- Share findings (N, benchmark/target, goal met, eye-opening results)

Improvement Through Assessment

- How results were used (e.g., change in procedures, course-level changes, resource allocation changes. etc.)
- Sharing with others? (e.g., program faculty, college curriculum committee, students, advisory boards, etc.)
- Challenges in the past academic year
- GI2025 efforts
- Upload updated documents (i.e., assessment plan, curriculum matrix)
- Upload documents for additional feedback
