59	Percentage at a certain level	Yes	SLO# 2 data was 52.39% Excellent, 37.12% Above Average, 10.10% Average, 0% Below Average, and 0% Not Met. The program benchmark was at 75% of Excellent and Above Average. The scores have exceeded program expectations in both SLOs: scored 91.81% for SLO#1 and 89.51 % for SLO#2. The assessed senior capstone class was fully synchronous online in AY2021- 22 and will continue to be fully online instruction due to our discipline's new trend toward hybrid/remote work. The high SLO scores indicate that remote learning in visual communication design is apparently effective in meeting the objectives. We are able to practice mock interviews via zoom, participate in online peer critiques on their portfolios, and meet/communicate with guest speakers which simulates recent business practices.

The past academic year posed both challenges and opportunities. Please share any assessment discoveries (e.g., insights about assessment procedures, great achievements, etc.) regarding program assessment in 2021-2022 so that others may learn from your experiences.

The assessment scores have been greater than our benchmarks. This appears to be a trend of synchronous online instruction. While the high scores are a delightful result and demonstrate a high level of student confidence and mastery of the SLOs, the committee plans to revisit assessment strategies to determine if more specifics would lead to a more accurate assessment of SLO mastery regardless of the learning environment.
