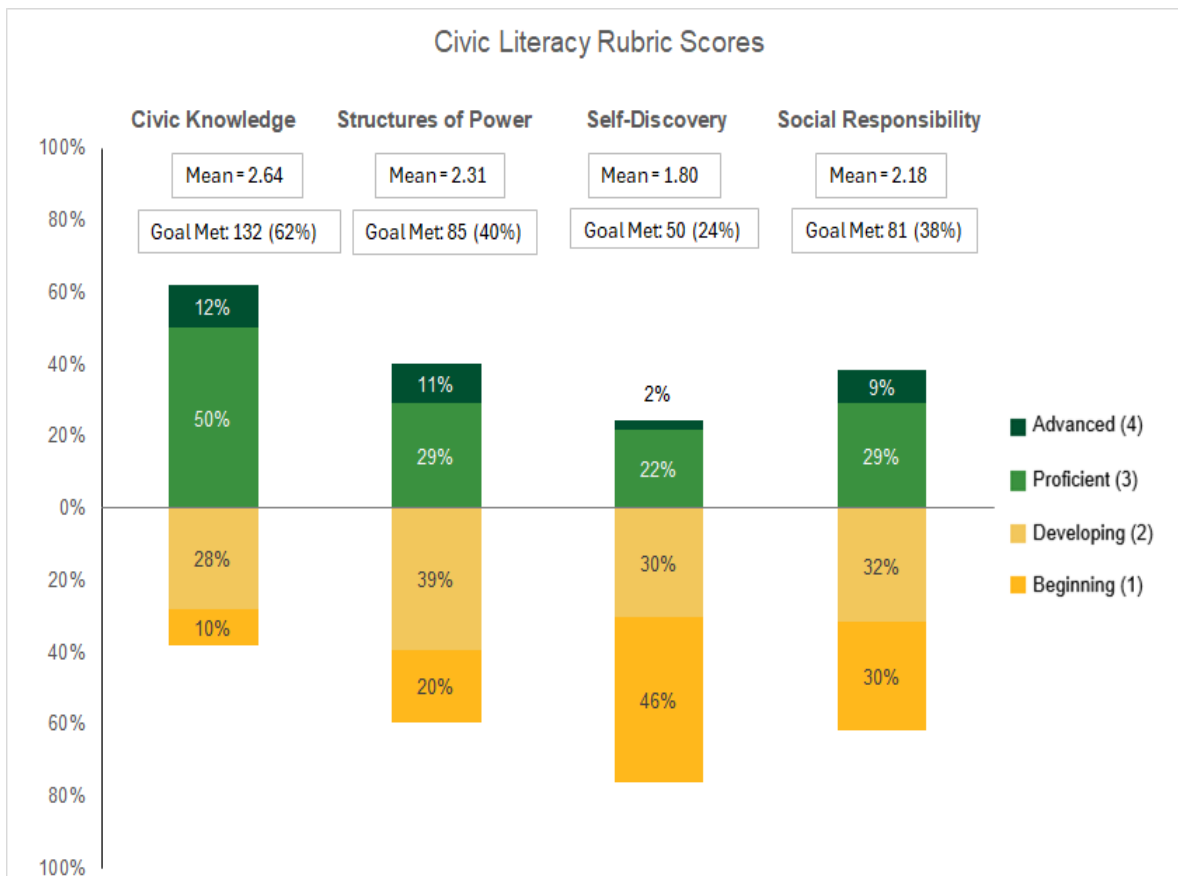

## Direct Evidence

**CPP Goal**  
“Advanced (4)” and “Proficient (3)”

**Goal Met**  
62% Civic Knowledge

**Goals Not Met**  
40% Structure of Power  
24% Self-Discovery  
38% Social Responsibility

## Indirect Evidence

### National Survey of Student Engagement (NSSE)

- 19% enrolled in service-learning courses
- 38% discussed social, political, philosophical issues
- 45% of seniors discussed ethical consequences of actions

### CPP's Graduating Senior Survey

- 67% of seniors felt CPP prepared them to help improve local and global communities
- 80% of seniors reported that CPP prepared them to understand responsibility to self and community
