

Understanding Students' Oral Communication Skills: Evidence from Fall 2021

<u>ILO</u>: Use **verbal**, written and listening skills to communicate persuasively and coherently

<u>GE SLO</u>: Speak effectively to various audiences



Oral Communication Rubric Scores



Central Message (strongest performance)

86.1%

Met CPP's goal of "advanced" and "proficient" levels

Delivery/platform Presence (greatest need for improvement)

41.7%

Performed at the "beginning" and "developing" levels as seniors – **did not** meet CPP's goal

Organization*

Only criterion where males performed **better** than females

Central Message* & Language*

Non-first-generation students performed **better** than first-generation students

* Statistically significant findings



NSSE data suggests CPP seniors "often" give a presentation in their course(s)

NSSE data suggests CPP contributed "some" to seniors' development in speaking clearly and effectively
