Purpose and Eligibility

Purpose

- Support faculty work in program-level assessment
- Build program-level assessment capacity

Eligibility:

- Continuing faculty (T/TT, FERP, lecturers)
- Department chairs not on contract

Awards, Uses, and Exclusions

• Range: \$750 - \$1,500 per project

- Uses:
 - Faculty* stipends (not staff/students)
 - Supplies, e.g., books
 - Fees, e.g., external speaker
- Exclusions:
 - Previously supported
 - Alternate funding

^{*} Some exception for department chairs

Grant Application

- Title
- Lead faculty, additional faculty
- Description
 - Rationale and purpose (150-word limit)
 - Learning outcome(s) to be examined
 - Assessment cycle stage (e.g., development, closing the loop, other)
 - Timeline with action steps
- Impact on various populations
- Key deliverables
- Budget
- Support statement from department chair

Additional Responsibilities

- Grant summary due Sept 15th
- 2023 Summer Assessment Institute

Special Considerations

- Closing the loop
- Equity and inclusion
- Critical thinking
- Written communication
