

CSU-Wide Funding Opportunities

COAST (CSU Council on ocean affairs, science and technology)

Grant Development Program. \$5,000 to \$20,000 for research on the open and coastal ocean, coastal zones, and coastal watersheds. These are initiation grants to develop full proposals for external funding agencies. For tenure stream faculty; lectures can also participate, but require a tenure stream faculty member to serve as a “sponsor”.

Rapid Response Funding Program. \$2,500 to \$7,500 for marine and coastal projects that require a quick response due to unexpected or sudden events. For tenure stream faculty; lectures can also participate, but require a tenure stream faculty member to serve as a “sponsor”.

Seminar Speaker Series Program. \$350 to \$700 to reimburse costs for speakers on COAST related issues. Tenured/tenure track faculty serves as “host”.

Short Course and Workshop Funding Program. \$3,000 to \$10,000 to promote COAST related research and education. For tenure stream faculty. Lectures can also participate but not as PI.

Strategic Investment Program. \$15,000 to \$45,000 to support multi-investigator teams; to develop larger proposals. For tenure stream faculty. Lectures can also participate but not as PI and cannot receive assigned time.

Entrepreneurial Joint Venture Matching Grant Program. Up to \$25,000. Provides support for CSU faculty engaged in external biotechnology-partnerships. Open to tenure stream faculty. Other CSU staff can be listed as co-PIs or key personnel.

Faculty-Student Collaborative Research: New Investigator Grant Program. Up to \$15,000. Open to tenured/tenure-track CSU faculty who have not yet received external support for their CSU-based research programs. Other CSU staff can be listed as co-PIs or key personnel.

Faculty-Student Collaborative Research: Development Grant Program, Up to \$15,000. Open to tenured/tenure-track CSU faculty who have received external support for their CSU-based research programs. Other CSU staff can be listed as co-PIs or key personnel.

As of May 2016

Faculty Travel Grant Program. Up to \$1,500

Presidents' Commission Scholars Program: Up to \$8,000 to support undergraduate research.

Curriculum Development Grant Program. Up to \$15,000.

Student Travel Grant Program. Up to \$1,500

System wide competitive research proposals. \$75,000 - \$150,000 per year, up to three years. Match required.

Cal Poly Pomona campus competitive proposals. No minimum, up to \$150,000 per year, up to three years. Match required.

Cal Poly Pomona seed funding. Up to \$10,000 no match required.

Faculty Research Incentive Award Program. Assigned time funding for academic year. Faculty member(s) commit to develop and submit full proposal for external funding. Can involve a single campus or multiple campuses. Only tenure stream faculty are eligible.
