**Subject**: Canvas tips for midterm, new programs and resources

Dear faculty,

As we get into midterm season, here are a couple of super-practical Canvas tips:

- We recommend <u>hiding Totals</u> in student grade summaries until later in the semester. This is because Canvas excludes ungraded assignments from the Total grade calculation, causing total grades to skew high early in the semester; in other words your students see a high total grade because they just haven't gotten to those assignments yet and/or you haven't been able to grade the assignments yet.
- A good practice is to <u>set the default grade for an assignment</u> to "0" after you have finished grading, just be sure not to overwrite already-entered grades. This is because assignments must actually be graded to factor into the total grade that you see. Any items showing a single dash ( ) in the Gradebook (i.e., assignments not submitted) will be excluded from the total, giving a misleadingly high Total grade. Defaulting to "0" factors missing assignments into the Total.
