Subject: Useful first day activity, Canvas reminder, and LOTS of cool opportunities

Dear faculty,

Well, a hurricane and an earthquake are a tough act to follow for an exciting start to the semester!

From first-year classes to final graduate seminars, here is a super-productive investment of first-day or first-week time: **Take 15 minutes for students to pull out their calendars and block class meetings plus hours per week outside of class meetings.** Have them put in *START* dates for exam reviews and projects, as well as the *due* dates. You can do it along with them, calendaring time for preparation and feedback.

For hours per week outside of class, be honest. Don't say to calendar 10 hours if 3 hours is realistic. If 10-15 hours outside of class is really needed, tell students *why* and encourage them that this is normal for the course. Sometimes students think they're "not good at this" when things take time to learn, and that's not true. Here's a nifty workload estimator.

And here's some more first-day ideas.
