### Canvas News

- Zoom Cloud Recordings: IT has identified an issue preventing new Zoom cloud recordings
  from automatically appearing in Kaltura. The good news is that your recordings are saved—
  they're just not being properly assigned to your Kaltura account. Until the vendor
  implements a permanent fix, IT staff are manually linking recordings to your "My Media"
  page twice per business day.
  - o *Tip:* If you need your recording sooner, you can contact the IT Service Desk with your Zoom meeting ID, and ask them to retrieve your recording.
  - Please note that Kaltura itself is fully operational. If you prefer, you can record locally to your computer and then manually upload your video to <u>Kaltura</u>. IT will update their <u>status page</u> and send an email notice to faculty when the issue is resolved.
- YouTube Ads: The addition of ads to YouTube videos shared via Canvas has been postponed to **October 31**. If you'd like to avoid ads when sharing media, you can continue <u>using</u> Kaltura as an ad-free alternative.
