



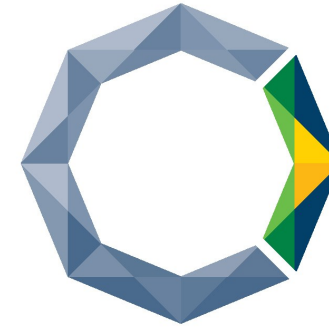
Cal Poly Pomona's Master of Science in Accountancy (MSA) program is designed to meet the needs of the ever-changing accounting profession, whether in public accounting, corporate accounting, government and not-for-profit accounting or some other areas of practice.

The program provides an integrated curriculum comprised of 30 credits featuring the sound theoretical, applied, analytical, and interdisciplinary courses that prepare students for a successful career in the profession. In the Accelerated MSA program, students take up to four courses per semester, enabling completion in a single calendar year.

Cal Poly Pomona's Graduate Business Programs have been accredited by the AACSB, a distinction that less than 5% of the world's 13,000 business programs have earned. AACSB schools produce graduates that are highly skilled and more desirable to employers than other non-accredited schools.
