A frequent contributor to the media, he has been interviewed by NPR, other national and local radio and television stations, the Los Angeles Times, the Los Angeles Daily News and its sister organizations, the San Francisco Chronicle, and numerous other news outlets.

In addition to his duties with Kleinhenz Economics, Robert is on the faculty at Cal State Long Beach and Associate Director of the University's Office of Economic Research.
