



## First Year Checklist

	Meet with <b>your advisor</b> regularly to develop an academic plan and explore academic resources
	Plan to take <b>30-semester units</b> in your first year and every subsequent year
	Strive to get a <b>2.0 GPA or higher</b> (CPP, Overall, and Major)
	For freshmen: Plan to complete your <b>GE math and English requirements</b> in your first year For transfer students: Plan to complete your <b>lower-division prerequisites</b> in your first-year
	Review your <b>transfer credit</b> (Advanced Placement test credit, community college coursework, etc.) with your advisor and submit any necessary petitions
	Know how to read your <b>curriculum sheet</b> and <b>roadmap</b>
	Find a faculty member, staff member, peer mentor, or coach on campus that you can go to for questions and concerns
	Know how the <b>Learning Resource Center</b> can help you
	Check your <b>CPP email</b> regularly
	Know how <b>Student Health &amp; Wellness Services, Counseling &amp; Psychological Services, and Bronco Care Center</b> can help you
	Know the breakdown of <b>student fees</b> and learn how to read your <b>financial aid package</b> and <b>account balance</b>
	Confirm your major is the best fit for you. If you are considering a <b>different major</b> , visit an advisor as soon as possible. Explore career resources at the <b>Career Center</b>
	Explore <b>clubs, internships, and other extracurricular opportunities</b> in your major or majors you're interested
	Know how to navigate the <b>university website</b> and <b>look up contact information</b>
