

FAMILY CHRISTMAS TREE

Theme: Crafting/Christmas

Ages of Children: All ages

Materials Needed:

- 1. Construction Paper different colors
- 2. Scissors
- 3. Glue/Tape
- 4. Markers or Pens
- 5. Color pencils optional

Developmental Objectives/Domains:

- 1. The objective for this activity is for students to understand a little bit about their family while having fun.
- 2. They will create a christmas tree and put their family members on it, by conducting this they will be aware of their surroundings and have them thinking.

Procedure:

- 1. Students will cut out the Christmas tree out of the outline.
- 2. Glue the tree on a blank canvas.
- 3. Write your name at the top of the paper.

- 4. They will then proceed to cutting out any construction paper they have in half to make small circles just like ornaments.
- 5. After cutting out the ornaments students will write their name on a star they cut out and place at the top of the tree.
- 6. Then they will write family members' names on the ornaments and decorate it as they would like.
