

Drawing a Cartoon Bear

Theme: Animals

Curriculum Area: Visual and Performing Arts

Activity: Step by step how to draw a mouse

Age of Children: 5-7

Materials Needed: Paper, pencil, coloring pencils or crayons

Developmental Objectives/Domains: This activity will help children develop fine motor skills in their hands and wrists.

This activity enhances cognitive development with visual analysis and concentration skills.

This activity promotes understanding of doing things in an order to have the right outcome.

Procedure:

1. Set all your supplies out on the desk or table.
2. First, draw a large oval in the middle of your paper. It should take up most of the page, this is going to be the body and head of the bear.
3. Then draw two half circles on the top of the oval to make ears.
4. Next, draw a smaller oval towards the middle and bottom of the bear.
5. For the arms on either side of the large oval draw, two small ovals sticking out from the body.
6. Draw two small half-circles on the bottom of the body for feet.
7. For the face draw two small circles for eyes, below that draw a small circle for its nose. For the mouth below the nose draw a 'u' and then connect it with another 'u'.
8. Color your bear however you want.
