

Theme: Drawing Simple figures

Curriculum Area: Visual Arts(K.VA:Cr1.1)

<u>Activity:</u> In this activity, students will use various home materials to help them draw a simple figure. Students will use their imaginative skills to draw a strawberry. They will also be able to explore using various art materials such as colored pencils/crayons and markers. Students will have a video link to help guide them step by step to draw a strawberry.



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<u>Age of Children:</u> Any grade in elementary school(1st grade to 5th grade)

Materials Needed:

- Blank paper
- Colored pencils or crayons
- Markers
- Pencil
- Device to watch

Developmental Objectives/Domains: By participating in this activity, children will:

- 1. Develop their listening skills by following the video below to help in guiding the drawing of a strawberry.
- 2. Understand the conditions, attitudes and conditions that support creativity.
- 3. Enhance cognitive development by innovative thinking and creativity to support their creative thinking process.

Procedure:

- 1. Ask the students questions regarding different art projects/drawings they've done.
- 2. Have students take out all required material(pencil,colors,white piece of paper and device).
- 3. Begin to play video(link below)
- 4. Follow video as directed to draw strawberry
- 5. Pause at any point in video as necessary
- 6. Once finished following video to draw strawberry, begin to use your colors to color in strawberry as one likes
- 7. Once finished drawing and coloring strawberry, write name at the bottom of the page so everyone knows who the drawing belongs too
