Happy Memories

Theme: Happy memories

Curriculum Area: Writing Standards ELA

What is your happiest memory? Recall a time where you had the best day ever! Was it when you got your first bike? When you met your favorite superhero? Or, how about when you and your best friend played at the park? Write a story about your happiest memory!

Ages of Children: Second grade

Materials Needed:

- Lined paper
- Pencil

Developmental Objectives/Domains: By participating in this activity, children will:

- 1. Enhance their language art skills as they use new vocabulary such as "memory".
- 2. Develop the ability to recall information from experiences to tell a story.

Procedure:

- 1. Ask the children the question of what are some of their happiest memories.
- 2. Explain that they will be writing a story telling that happiest memory.
- 3. Pass out the lined paper and pencils, have the children write their name on the top right corner, and their title to begin with.
- 4. Once they have established a title they may now begin writing their story.
- 5. Allow them as much time as needed, and once they are finished read the stories together!
