



Multiplication Facts Activity!

Theme: Multiplication Facts Activity

Curriculum Area: Mathematics(2.1)

Activity: In this activity, students will use their knowledge on their multiplication facts to complete the multiplication worksheet below. Students will be given a worksheet with missing boxes in the multiplication table to fill out. Some boxes have been pre-filled, but the missing ones will have to be filled out. The worksheet contains multiplication numbers between 1 and 10.

Age of Children: 3rd Grade

Materials Needed:

- Printer to print worksheet out
- Pencil

Developmental Objectives/Domains: By participating in this activity, children will:

1. Develop their memorization skills to help fill out the multiplication table.
2. Understand the skills learned on the multiplication facts
3. Enhance their knowledge further on the multiplication facts by filling in the missing pieces.

Procedure:

1. Print out worksheet below
2. Start from number 1 to 10 to fill out multiplication chart

3. Use your pencil to fill in missing cells
4. Once finished filling all the boxes your multiplication chart is complete
