Age of Children: 4-6 graders (9-12 years old)

## Materials Needed:

- 1. Construction Paper (any color)
- 2. White piece of paper
- 3. Color pencils or markers
- 4. Glue

## Developmental/Objective Domain:

- 1. With completing this activity students will be able to not only learn about themselves, but as well motivate them.
- 2. This activity will help students be aware of their abilities, but as well grow each time they complete one of their goals.

## Procedure:

- 1. Obtain all your materials.
- 2. With the construction paper you have chosen, fold it in half.
- 3. Then take the white piece of paper, fold it in half and glue on to the construction paper you folded.
- 4. Do not forget to write your name.
- 5. On the left side write 5 goals you would like to achieve in the classroom.
- 6. On the right side write 5 goals you would like to achieve at home.
- 7. After writing your goals at the bottom of the paper sign your name and the year you will complete your goals.

- 8. Then proceed to decorate your activity the way you want.
- 9. Also do not forget to decorate the front of your book!
