

PUMPKIN SHAPE COUNT

Theme: Halloween/Crafting

Curriculum area: Math/Visual Arts

Ages of Children: 4th-6th grade (9-12 years old)

Materials needed:

- 1. Construction paper (balck, green, orange)
- 2. Circles, triangles, and Squares
- 3. Scissors
- 4. Pencil
- 5. Glue

Developmental Objectives/Domain:

- 1. Students will be able to create different shapes on their own and with this they will gain understanding of how a different shape looks.
- 2. They will challenge themselves by thinking about the number of shapes they need to make their pumpkin look good and scary.

Procedure:

- 1. Obtain your black and orange construction paper.
- 2. With the orange paper cut out and oval shape to have it be your pumpkin.
- 3. Then proceed to decorate your pumpkin the way you want, but with different shapes they can't all be the same.
- 4. After you complete decorating your pumpkin, write down how many shapes of each shape you used using a white piece of paper, and then proceed to glue it down below your pumpkin.
- 5. Do not forget to write your name when you are done
