Theme: Family

Curriculum: Visual and Performing Arts

Activity: Let's make a family tree! Depending on how long you want to go back in your family, you can decide that on your own. For the purpose of my example, I went back up to my Grandparents (:

Age group: All Ages

Materials needed:

- Poster board cut to your preferred size.
- Colorful construction paper to make little cut outs to decorate your tree.
- You will need an older person to print out pictures for your cut outs and tittle name.
- Markers (If you would like to just draw the details out on your own, that will also be perfect!)
- Next, you will need pictures of the family members that you want to include.
- Glue
- Stickers (Optional)

Developmental Objectives/Domains:

- 1. Develop the understanding of what a family is, how it was structured, and know about your family.
- 2. Understand what it is to put in work to a job that requires work and patience.
- 3. What a family symbolizes to you and your own family.

Procedure:

- 1. First you must start by getting your family photos together and choosing the best pictures to include in your tree.
- 2. Next, you will need glue and make sure that your tree is already drawn out with the number of branches that you will include (family members). You will write out a title, the name of each family member, including who they are. (ex: mother, father, brother, sister, grandpa(mom), grandma(father)).
- 3. Then you will glue the pictures to your tree as you wish.
