
Hand Washing



Theme: Germs

Curriculum Area: Science

Activity: The children will learn about how germs spread and how they can reduce the spread of germs.

Age of Children: 4-5 years of age

Materials Needed:

- Lotion
- Glitter
- Bowl
- Cleaning materials: paper towels, child safe spray

Developmental Domains/ Objectives:

- 1. Develop an understanding of germs and how they can spread.
- 2. Enhance their independent hygiene skills.
- 3. They will learn to be responsible with their handwashing.

Procedure:

- 1. Have a discussion with the children about germs. Ask them questions like can we see germs, what can germs do to us and how can we get rid of germs.
- 2. Have the children wash their hands.

- 3. Have the children help you mix the lotion and glitter in a bowl with their hands.
- 4. Then, ask them individually to touch items around the class with the lotion and glitter on their hands. "Please grab me a ruler" or "help me push in chairs.
- 5. Next, explain that the glitter is like germs on our hands before we wash them.
- 6. Have the children wash their hands.
- 7. Challenge the children to use the cleaning products to clean up all the "germs" (glitter) around the room.
