- 1. Brown. Orange, and White construction paper
- 2. Paper Plate
- 3. Glue
- 4. Black Marker

Developmental/Objective Domain:

1. Upon completing this activity students will be able to create their own work, but as well analyze and interpret their own work.

Procedure:

- 1. Obtain a paper plate.
- 2. With the brown paper draw an oval shape towards the middle of the paper. Cut it out.
- 3. Grab the white paper and make some circles. These will be your eyes.
- 4. In any order now grab your construction paper and place your hand towards the center and trace.
- 5. After tracing your hand, cut all of them out.
- 6. You will then begin glueing all your pieces together.
- 7. Begin with the paper plate and face down to the table and glue all your hands.
- 8. Then turn the paper plate over and then proceed to glueing down your body and the face ass well.

9. Then decorate in any way that you want to decorate your turkey do not forget to name it.
