
The Age of the Dinosaurs



Theme: Dinosaurs

Curriculum Area: Science

Activity: The children will practice their math skills in a fun way.

Age of Children: 4-5 years of age

Materials Needed:

- Colored and laminated copies of the dinosaurs above in red, blue and yellow. (5 of Each color and type of dinosaur.)
- Small boxes with pictures of these dinosaurs on the outside. (1 box for each color and type of dinosaur)
- A red box, yellow box and a blue box to sort color only.
- This activity will be okay if the students work together in a group of 4 (max) because there are so many dinosaurs so you will bring 4 dinosaur figurines so the students know when it is their turn to participate. They can participate when they are given the dinosaur.

Developmental Domains/ Objectives:

- 1. **DRDP Domain:** (COG 1)
- 2. Sorts accurately based on two or more groups based on one attribute
- 3. Sorts accurately based on two or more groups based on one attribute, then puts all the objects together and resorts the entire collection into new groups
- 4. Sorts objects into two groups based on at least two attributes, sometimes sorting by one attribute and then subdividing those groups based on a second attribute

Procedure:

- 1. Invite the children to the table to help sort dinosaurs.
- 2. Ask them to sort the dinosaurs by color into the correct boxes.
- 3. Then, ask them to sort the dinosaurs by type into the correct boxes.

4. Next, have them sort the dinosaurs by color and type into the correct boxes.
