
The Wonky Donkey



Theme: On the Farm

Curriculum Area: Creative art

Activity: The children will use their motor skills and imagination to create art. They will

hopefully relate their art to the story at Circle Time, The Wonky Donkey. It is a funny story that

will probably grab their attention. Since it is creative art, they can make whatever they like.

Age of Children: 4-5 years of age

Materials Needed:

- construction paper
- scissors
- markers
- googly eyes
- pre-cut yarn
- glue (pre-squeezed, sticks and bottle)
- green folded paper and tinsel
- dried moss
- hay

Developmental Domains/ Objectives:

- 1. DRDP Domain: (VPA 1) Child engages, develops skills, and expresses self with increasing creativity, complexity, and depth through two-dimensional and three-dimensional visual art.
- 2. Creates two-dimensional and three-dimensional representations of things; and experiments with detail and color.

- 3. Creates two-dimensional and three-dimensional representations to show action or how things relate to one another, using detail, shape, color, or, organization.
- 4. Creates increasingly complex two-dimensional and three-dimensional representations that are expressive mood, feeling or interaction among things, using detail, shape, color, or organization.

Procedure:

- 1. Invite students to come to the center. (Giving Cues)
- 2. Explain what is on the table and name the materials and answer their questions. (giving quality feedback)
- 3. Encourage the children to make whatever they want. (encouraging)
- 4. Have them write their names first. (giving cues) Here is where they will possibly hit **every** level of the DRDP **depending** on what they make.
- 5. Co Construct with the children. (co constructing)
- 6. Ask them deep questions about their art when they have had enough time to get started and think about their art. (questioning) This is where you would find out which level the child reached depending on their answers.
