Tiny T. Rex



Theme: Dinosaurs and more

**Curriculum Area:** Creative art

**Activity:** The children will use their motor skills and imagination to create art. They will hopefully relate their art to the story at Circle Time, Tiny T. Rex and the Impossible Hug. Since it is creative art, they can make whatever they like.

**Age of Children:** 4-5 years of age

Materials Needed: All of this is sold at the Dollar Tree

- googly eyes
- small and large dinosaur figurines
- paint
- paint brushes
- reindeer moss
- homemade cut out spikes from paper
- plastic easter eggs
- homemade cut out dinosaur shapes from burlap ribbon
- glitter glue
- burlap ribbon
- garden tape

## **Developmental Domains/ Objectives:**

- 1. DRDP Domain: (VPA 1) Child engages, develops skills, and expresses self with increasing creativity, complexity, and depth through two-dimensional and three-dimensional visual art.
- 2. Creates two-dimensional and three-dimensional representations of things; and experiments with detail and color.
- 3. Creates two-dimensional and three-dimensional representations to show action or how things relate to one another, using detail, shape, color, or, organization.
- 4. Creates increasingly complex two-dimensional and three-dimensional representations that are expressive mood, feeling or interaction among things, using detail, shape, color, or organization.

## Procedure:

- 1. Invite students to come and sit or stand at the table. (approximately 6 students at a time) (Giving Cues)
- 2. Explain what is on the table and name the materials. Answer their questions if they are still unsure (giving quality feedback)
- 3. Encourage the children to make whatever they want. (encouraging)
- 4. Have them write their names on their art before they begin construction. (giving cues)
- 5. Co Construct with the children if needed. (co constructing)
- 6. Ask them questions about their art when they have had enough time to know what they are making and why. (questioning)
