MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Earned doctorate preferred; M.A. required; 3-5 years as a credentialed teacher in public schools required (or may include other comparable K-12 teaching experiences). Related background desired in specific coursework area, i.e.: teacher education methodology or foundations, bilingual education, literacy and language, curriculum & instruction, Education Specialist, Reading Specialist, science (physics, geo-science, chemistry), mathematics, social science, art, PE, music.

Supervisors must be experts in the instructional area of the candidate being supervised and must have: (a) current knowledge of the content; b) knowledge of the current context of public schooling including the California adopted P-12 content standards, frameworks, and accountability systems; c) knowledge of diversity in society, including diverse abilities, culture, language, ethnicity, and gender orientation; and d) demonstration of effective professional practices in teaching and learning, and/or *scholarship*, and/or *service*.

Appointments are made based on the need for the course(s) to be taught, the part-time faculty member's qualifications for the course(s), and the department chairperson's careful consideration based on the lecturer's entitlements within the department. Course assignments may be rescinded if the course does not reach minimal enrollment or if the course needs to be taught by tenure-line faculty. Temporary appointments are made one term at a time (approximately 16 weeks) for weighted teaching units (wtu) ranging from .05 to 15. All faculty are expected to have knowledge of or gain knowledge on basic technology requirements as needed for the assignment e.g. Canvas, Bronco Direct for class rosters and submitting grades, Cal Poly e-mail for CPP transactions, Word, Excel, Adobe Acrobat, video software for supervision.
