The goal for Liberal Studies faculty advising is to address the whole student through conversations about students' issues, needs, and interests regarding academic performance and progress. Below are four general areas advisors cultivate in their practice, which will have different emphasis based on students' situations.



MENTORSHIP & CARE

Relate with students by cultivating a safe and inviting space for questions and conversations about academic and professional success.

CAREER PLANNING



Identify, strategize and refer students to career options, services and experiences early and often to prepare them for a desired career and to develop professional skills while still in college.



PERSONAL AND PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

Identify, recommend and refer students to personal and professional experiences (including volunteering, study abroad and graduate school) early and often to foster personal abilities and professionalism.

ACADEMIC DEVELOPMENT



Identify and recommend study skills and academic action to improve students' performance overall. Make referrals as needed.
