What to do:

- (1) Choose: Liberal Studies K-8 Pre-credential: Elementary Education Option / LS Teaching Option
- (2) Choose a Science Education Minor
- (3) At Completion of LS Degree enter a Multiple Subjects Teaching Credential Program
- (4) Upon Completion of a Credential Program, apply for your Multiple Subjects Teaching Credential *and* add a Supplementary Authorization to teach Biology/Chemistry OR Physics/Geology up to 9th grade.

Requirements:

Core Liberal Studies Courses (9 units)

Required Science Courses (21 units)

Total: 30 units

For the required science courses, students choose the Biology/Chemistry plan or Physics/Geology plan based on their interests and strengths.
