- Grade of “D-” is consider passing for **some GEs**, however...need **2.0 GPAs** to graduate and at least a **2.5 Overall GPA** to meet the credential program GPA requirement

GE Areas **1A, 1B, 1C**, and **2**

“**C -**” or better

All ECS Coursework

“**C**” or better

University Policies

Repeating/Retaking Classes

- Retake any any class that you earned a “C-” or lower in for up to three (3) times.
- “Grade Forgiveness” is earned when you retake a class at CPP.
 - The first grade will be excluded from your GPA.
- A maximum of **16 credits** can be forgiven.

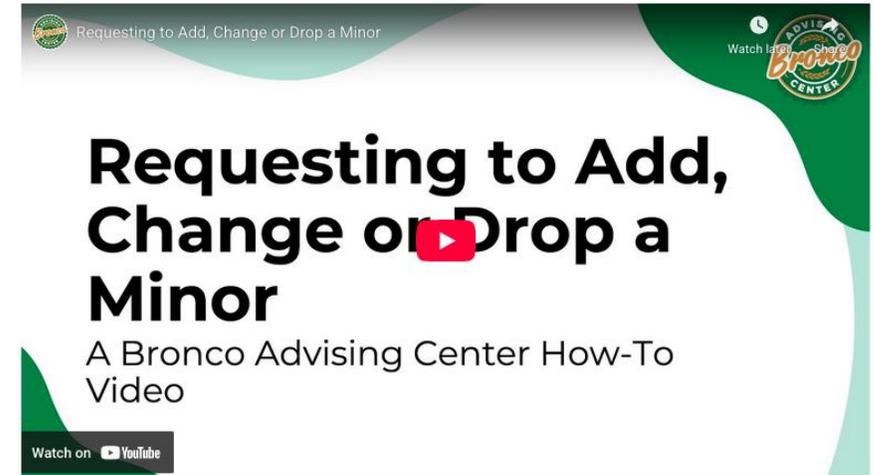
Adding a Minor

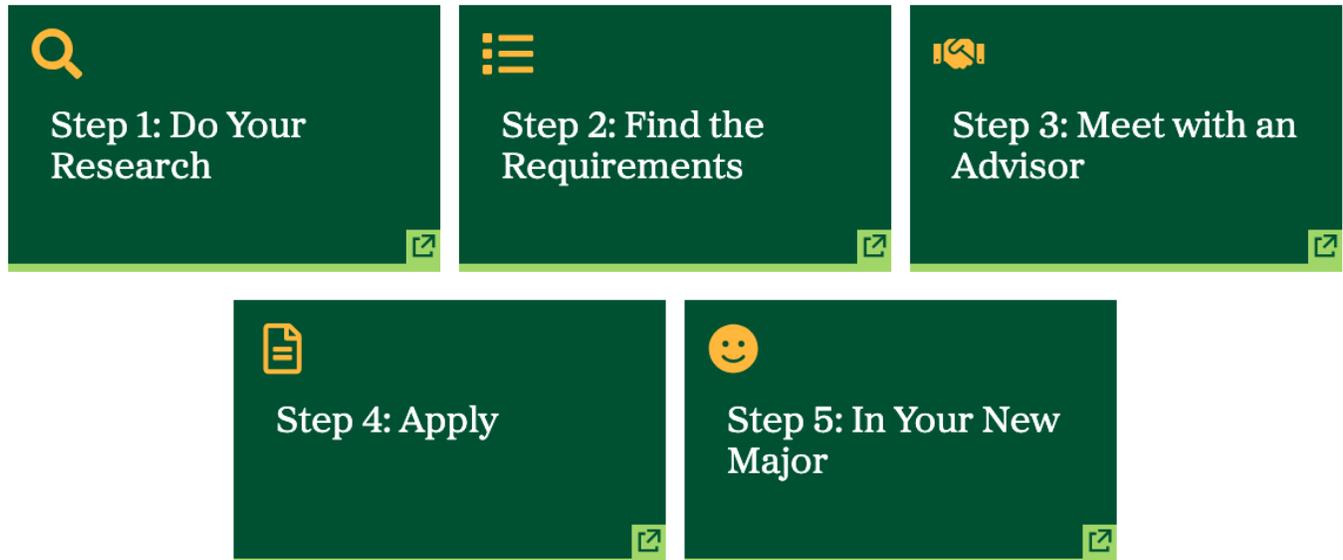


University Policies

- Register for fall semester classes in April (your registration window should post ~ 3/26/26)

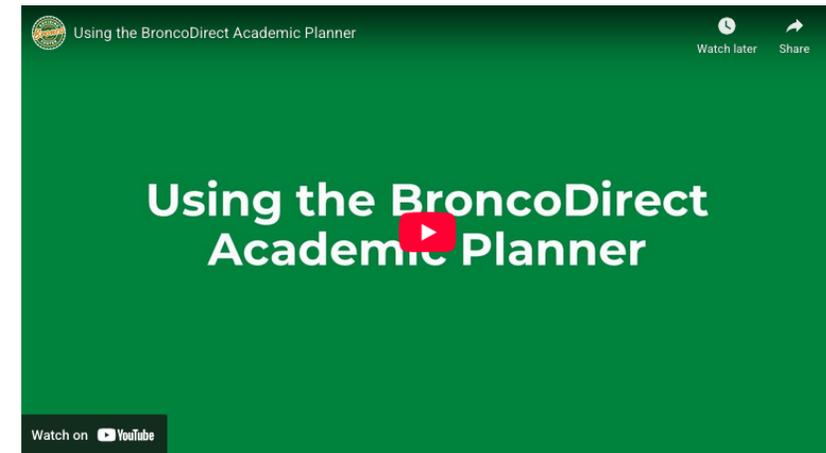

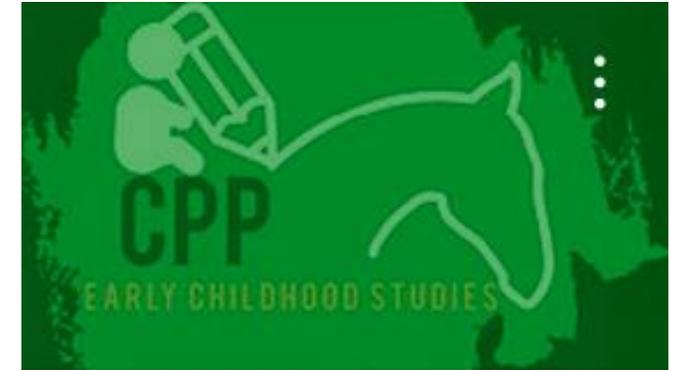
