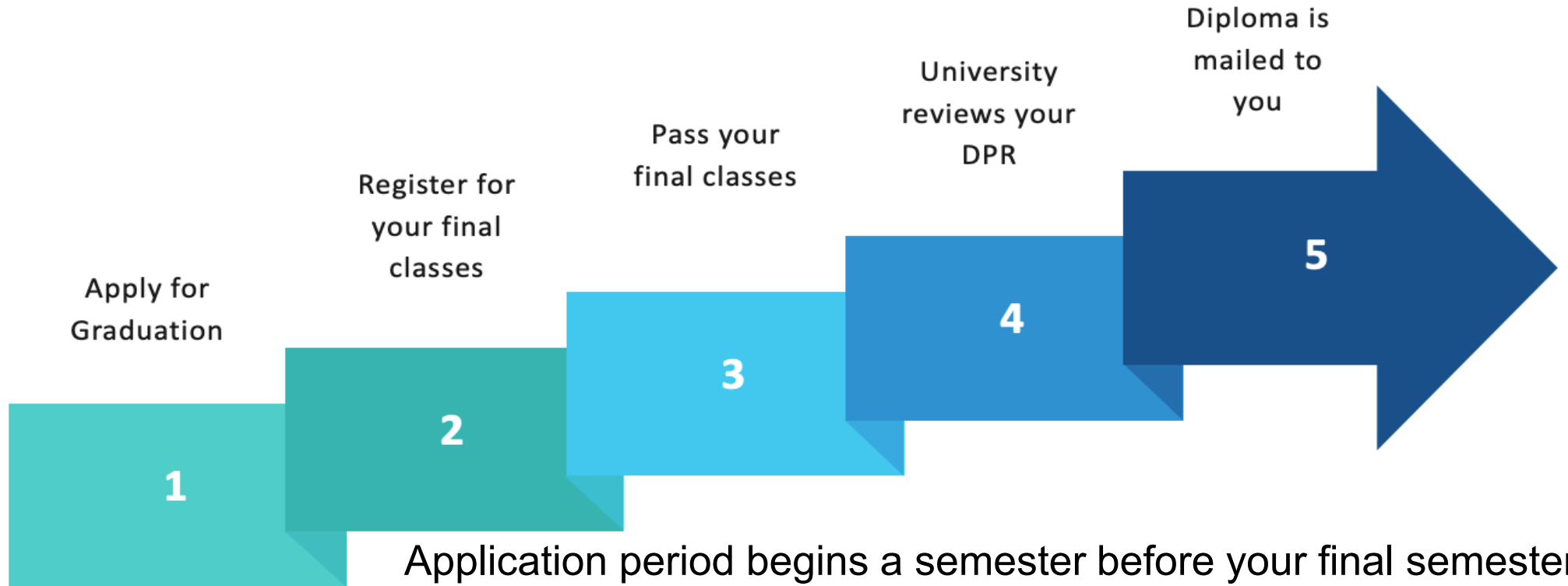

1. Plan to complete at least 120 units, 50 of which are from a 4-yr institution, and at least 30 of those must be from CPP)

TIP : use your CPP transcript to find your overall units completed as of today, NOT the DPR.

Review your Degree Progress Report (DPR)

Important things to remember

- The DPR will apply any class(es) that you've registered for towards units "taken" and requirement areas.
- Your Student Success Advisor can submit requests and/or petitions to adjust classes on your DPR.
- A grade of "C" or higher is required in all courses used in the ECS Major.
- GE Synthesis classes (3C/C3, 4C/D4, 5D/B5) can only be used to satisfy one GE Area, but they can also count towards your major.
- You can only get credit for a class once, unless it's repeatable for credit. If you retake a class that you already earned credit for, be sure to prepare for your units to get adjusted.
- Edits to your DPR take a *really* long time to process.

General Information

The [Degree Progress Report \(DPR\)](#) helps you and your academic advisor monitor your progress, track your completed classes or planning your term-by-term coursework. You should work with your academic advisor at the advising center. 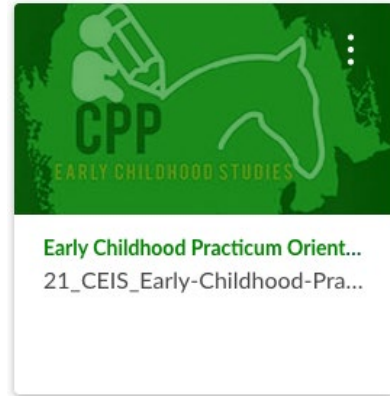



1. Create a plan for graduation

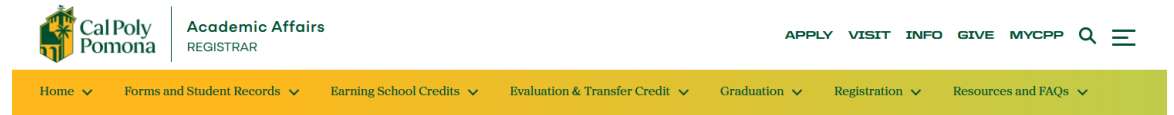
- Review your DPR to identify your remaining classes.

Apply for Graduation

How to...

You may wish to view the [How to Apply for Graduation Online via BroncoDirect \(PDF\)](#) form if you need a step-by-step guide on how to apply online. Students must submit a graduation application through [BroncoDirect](#) by the appropriate deadline. Students failing to submit their application by the appropriate deadline may be required to graduate in a future semester. Do not apply online if you do not see your desired graduation term in BroncoDirect. Please email registrar@cpp.edu for assistance.

Graduation Fee

After you apply for graduation, you will need to pay a non-refundable Graduation Application Fee. You only pay the fee once per academic career and program. You can pay in your BroncoDirect Student Center (view [How to Pay Your Graduation Fees on BroncoDirect \(PDF\)](#)). Failing to pay the fee may prevent your diploma from being released.

- Application Fee through Summer 2025: \$59
- Application Fee Beginning Fall 2025: \$125

The fee covers the cost of your diploma, administrative review, commencement ceremony, and more. If you have questions about the Commencement ceremonies, email commencement@cpp.edu.

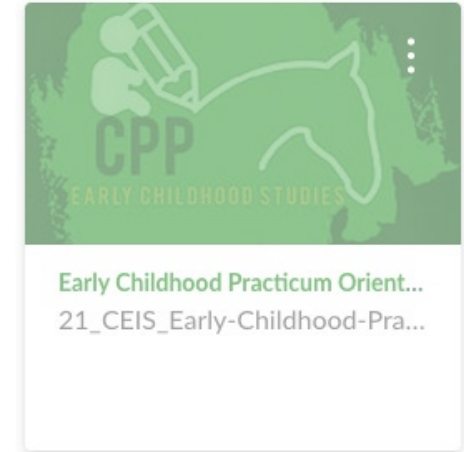

Summer or Fall Practicum Class

For placement in the **Summer or Fall** semesters, applications can open **December 1st** and close **February 1st at 11:59pm.**



ECS Course Updates:

- **ECS 3000 turned into ECS 4750 which is now ECS 4750W - writing course**
- **ECS 3900 is now ECS 4210**
- **ECS 4200 is now ECS 3910**
- **ECS 4300 can be satisfied by either ECS 3310 or ECS 3320.**
- **ECS 3500 can be satisfied by ECS 3310**

ECS 3500/ECS 3250 and ECS 3200 are no longer offered

Students can now satisfy these requirements by completing one of the following for each requirement:

- ECS 1200
- ECS 2300 (transfer from community college)

- GSC 3500: Natural Disasters (only if taken before SPR 2026)

- GEO 3510: Geography of California
- **Non-Teaching students:** students can meet with advisor and advisor can email Dr. Kennedy to get approval and/or identify alternate courses

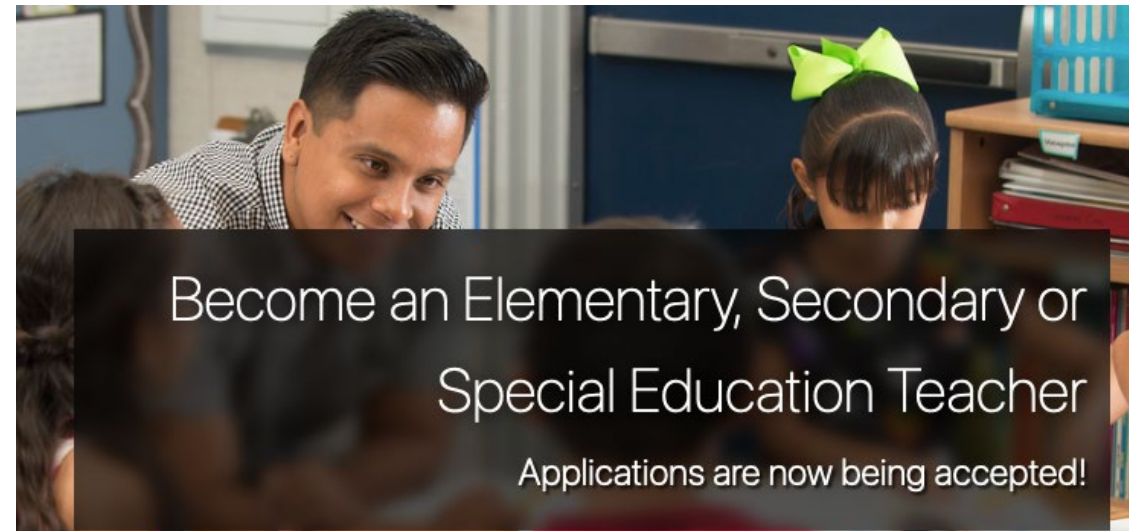
