English & Modern Languages Advising Milestones

Spanish major – 4-year students

Meeting these milestones will keep you on track to graduation: try to complete the following requirements by the year in your education indicated. You should plan to take 10 courses per year (averaging 5 per semester). You need 120 semester units to graduate.

Year 1

- Complete two Spanish Intermediate level courses: SPN 2120 or SPN 2112, and SPN 2130
 - If you are a native speaker of Spanish, take SPN 2120. If you are not a native speaker of Spanish, take SPN 2112. (Note that to enroll in SPN 2112 you need to either complete SPN 2111 or be placed in 2112.)
 - SPN 2120/2112 is a prerequisite for major required core and major electives courses
 - SPN 2130 is a prerequisite for some major required core courses
 - If you need to begin Spanish at the Elementary level, get started in either SPN 1111:
 Elementary Spanish I or SPN 1130: Spanish for Spanish Speakers I. Contact Dr. Dr. Isabel Bustamante with placement questions.
- **GE A2: Written Communication** ENG 1100 + 1101: Stretch Composition I + II *or* ENG 1103: First-year Composition
- GE B4: Quantitative Reasoning MAT 1900/A + 1910: Quantitative Reasoning and Problem-Solving or STA 1201/A + STA 1202: Statistics with Applications Stretch I + II
- Other **lower-division GE courses:** A1, A3, B1, B2, B3, C1, C2a, C2b, D1, D2, D3. Note that if you took AP Spanish, your C2b requirement is already fulfilled. If you still need to fulfill C2b, we strongly recommend you take a course in a language other than Spanish, such as FR 1111 or GER 1111.

Year 2

- **GE A3: Critical Thinking** (if you didn't complete it in your first year) ENG 2105: Written Reasoning (recommended) *or* PHL 2020: Critical Thinking
- Make progress on other **lower-division GE courses** (everything except B5, C3, and D4)
- Make progress in your **major required core**. Take at least one of the Advanced Language courses (SPN 3110, 3120, and 3130).

Year 3

- Complete lower-division GE courses
- Begin upper-division GE courses (B5, C3, D4)
- Make progress on your major required core and major electives

Year 4

- Culminating Experience SPN 4610: Spanish Capstone
- Complete upper-division GE courses
- Complete major required core and major electives

Spanish major – 2-year students

Meeting these milestones will keep you on track to graduation: try to complete the following requirements by the year in your education indicated. You should plan to take 10 courses per year (averaging 5 per semester). You need 120 semester units to graduate.

Year 1

- Check whether you need to take any courses required for **lower-division GEs**
- If you haven't taken their equivalents already, complete the two Spanish Intermediate level courses: SPN 2120 or SPN 2112, and SPN 2130
 - If you are a native speaker of Spanish, take SPN 2120. If you are not a native speaker of Spanish, take SPN 2112. (Note that to enroll in SPN 2112 you need to either complete SPN 2111 or be placed at 2112.)
 - SPN 2120/2112 is a prerequisite for major required core and major electives courses
 - SPN 2130 is a prerequisite for some major required core courses
 - If you need to begin Spanish at the Elementary level, get started in either SPN 1111:
 Elementary Spanish I or SPN 1130: Spanish for Spanish Speakers I. Contact Dr. Dr. Isabel Bustamante with placement questions.
- Make progress on your major required core and major electives
- Begin **upper-division GE courses** (B5, C3, D4)

Year 2

- Culminating Experience SPN 4610: Spanish Capstone
- Complete upper-division GE courses
- Complete major required core and major electives
