

## Spanish major – 4-year students

Use this handout to prioritize the requirements on your Degree Curriculum Sheet (23-24). This will keep you on track to graduation: try to complete the following requirements by the year in your education indicated. Take 10 courses per year (averaging 5 per semester) to graduate in 4 years. You need 120 semester units to graduate.

Year 1

- SPN 1000: Spanish First Year Experience *or* SPN 1001: Intro to the Spanish Teaching Credential (take in Fall, if possible)
- Complete **two Intermediate level Spanish courses**: (1) SPN 2112 *or* SPN 2120, **and** (2) SPN 2130
  - If you are a native speaker of Spanish, take SPN 2120. If you are not a native speaker of Spanish, take SPN 2112. (*NOTE: to enroll in SPN 2112 you need to either complete SPN 2111 or be placed in 2112.*)
  - SPN 2120/2112 is a prerequisite for Major Required core and Major Electives courses
  - SPN 2130 is a prerequisite for some Major Required core courses
  - *If you need to begin Spanish at the Elementary level, get started in either SPN 1111: Elementary Spanish I or SPN 1130: Spanish for Spanish Speakers I. Contact Dr. Bustamante-López ([ibustamante@cpp.edu](mailto:ibustamante@cpp.edu)) with placement questions.*
- **GE A2: Written Communication** – follow your DSP placement: ENG 1100 (Fall) + 1101 (Spring) *or* ENG 1100M (Fa) + 1101M (Sp) *or* ENG 1103 (Fa or Sp) *or* ENG 1103M (Fa or Sp)
- **GE B4: Quantitative Reasoning** – follow your placement; consider MAT 1910: Survey of Mathematics *or* STA 1200: Statistics w/Applications *or* STA 1201/A + STA 1202: Statistics w/Applications Stretch I + II
- Other **lower-division GE courses**: A1, A3, B1, B2, B3, C1, C2, D1, D2, E, or F. *NOTE: if you took AP Spanish, part of your C2 requirement is already fulfilled. If you still need to fulfill C2, we strongly recommend you take a course in a language other than Spanish (CHN 1111, FRE 1111, or GER 1111).*

Year 2

- Make progress in your **Major Required core**. Prioritize SPN 3110 **and** 3120 *or* 3130 *or* 3160.
- Make progress on other **lower-division GE courses** (everything except B5, C3, and D4). Take GE A3 if you didn't in your first year.

Year 3

- Make progress on your **Major Required core** and **Major Electives**
- Complete **lower-division GE courses** (everything except B5, C3, and D4)
- Begin **upper-division GE courses** (B5, C3, D4). *NOTE: SPN 3420 counts both as a GE C3 and a Major Required course.*

Year 4

- Complete **Major Required core** and **Major Electives**
- **Culminating Experience** – SPN 4610: Spanish Capstone
- Complete **upper-division GE courses** (B5, C3, D4). *NOTE: SPN 3420 counts both as a GE C3 and a Major Required course.*

## Spanish major – 2-year students

Use this handout to prioritize the requirements on your Degree Curriculum Sheet (22-23). This will keep you on track to graduation: try to complete the following requirements by the year in your education indicated. You should plan to take 10 courses per year (averaging 5 per semester). You need 120 semester units to graduate. Note that a maximum of 70 semester units (105 quarter units) of community college course credit may be applied toward the BA.

### Year 1

- SPN 1000: Spanish First Year Experience *or* SPN 1001: Intro to the Spanish Teaching Credential (take in Fall, if possible)
- Check whether you need to take any courses required for **lower-division GEs** (everything except B5, C3, and D4)
- If you haven't taken their equivalents already, complete the **two Intermediate level Spanish courses**: (1) SPN 2112 *or* SPN 2120, **and** (2) SPN 2130
  - If you are a native speaker of Spanish, take SPN 2120. If you are not a native speaker of Spanish, take SPN 2112. (*NOTE: to enroll in SPN 2112 you need to either complete SPN 2111 or be placed at 2112.*)
  - SPN 2120/2112 is a prerequisite for major required core and major electives courses
  - SPN 2130 is a prerequisite for some major required core courses
  - *If you need to begin Spanish at the Elementary level, get started in either SPN 1111: Elementary Spanish I or SPN 1130: Spanish for Spanish Speakers I. Contact Dr. Bustamante-López ([ibustamante@cpp.edu](mailto:ibustamante@cpp.edu)) with placement questions.*
- Make progress on your **Major Required core** and **Major Electives**
- Take 1-2 **upper-division GE courses** (B5, C3, D4) *NOTE: SPN 3420 counts both as a GE C3 and a Major Required course.*

### Year 2

- Complete **Major Required core** and **Major Electives**
- **Culminating Experience** – SPN 4610: Spanish Capstone
- Complete **upper-division GE courses** (B5, C3, D4) *NOTE: SPN 3420 counts both as a GE C3 and a Major Required course.*
